

### GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION SYSTEM TEMPLATES

To: Schools Division Superintendents
This Region

- 1. As regards the provision of technical assistance and monitoring of learners' performance to improve quality, the Department of Education (DepEd) Region X is adopting a System on the Curriculum and Management Supervision.
- 2. Designed to present a blueprint for all instructional leaders to follow in terms of assistance to appropriate individuals, the Curriculum Management and Supervision System (CMSS) is a system-reference that provides information on the learners' performance in all levels.
- 3. Included in the CMSS are the different templates to be filled out every after quarterly assessment by the teachers, school heads, district supervisors, and regional and divisional supervisors.
- 4. The Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will schedule a regional orientation for this purpose.
- 5. Effective this school year, these templates shall be employed by all instructional leaders and will remain in force unless sooner repealed, amended, or rescinded.
- 6. Attached are the rationale and guidelines for reference.

### GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION SYSTEM TEMPLATES

#### RATIONALE

The results of the National Achievement Test (NAT) have driven all schools to design interventions aimed at increasing the average Mean Percentage Score (MPS) of schools in NAT. While the performance of learners in the school has been measured in a form of quarterly assessment, nothing has been done about tracking as to how many from these learners have been developed and considered learned because of the teachers' instruction.

#### GOAL

The goal of CMSS is to ensure that every learner is provided with appropriate instruction and that all acquire knowledge in all learning areas as evidenced by the ratings in the report card.

#### DESCRIPTION

Designed as a user-friendly system to ensure accurate, valid, and timely report from the concerned Curriculum Support System (CSS), CMSS is introduced through different templates.





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### Template 1- A - For the subject teacher

This template is to be filled out by the teacher handling the subject. All the ratings of the learners in class will be categorized according to the range indicated in the template. The same template will be used in all learning areas. After accomplishing the template, the teacher will forward a copy to the school head for consolidation.



Template 3 shall be generated from the CMS system so that the concerned EPS will have an idea on the specific grade level with low ratings in one's learning area as reference for policy recommendations.


