

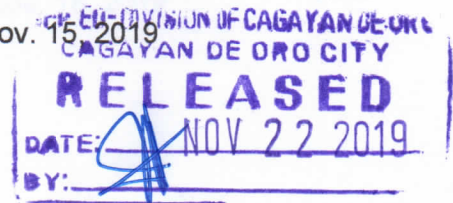

Greetings!

It is truly an honor for XUJHS to be given the GOLD award for Best Makers/Robotics Programme among the K-12 schools from across Asia Pacific countries in the recent EduTech Asia Awards 2019. The award recognizes a school that is improving coding and maker ability in its students through a well-equipped and innovative makers/robotics initiative. The maker programme, now on its fourth year, is initiated to engage students in activities focused on designing, building, modifying, and/or repurposing material objects, for playful or useful ends, oriented toward making a 'product'. In 2016, we were one of the pioneer 129 registered schools in 15 countries to host a school maker faire. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> run of the school maker faire brought an even bigger, more profound maker projects showcasing students' creativity and innovation applying the robotics skills learned in computer class.

As our TD partner, we are inviting our **TD partner schools** to join us in the **4<sup>th</sup> run of the XU Junior High School Maker Faire on November 28, 2019 from 7:30AM to 3:00PM**, as part of the Technology Week and XU Festival Days celebration. The aim is to engage our students in a demonstration or workshop on the various tools for making, stir interest among our students and empower them to take up STEAM. At these maker event, our Junior high students are gathered to share their maker projects and learn from one another. Some exhibitors are invited like 3D Printing of the XU American corner, robotics of Robogals Philippines, and our XU network of colleges would set up booths showcasing what they have built. Techfactor's RoboTek would also host hands-on workshops, while visitors, parents, and students would wander the grounds. We will also be holding a Pass-It-or-Play-It Quiz Bee among the TD tutees.




