 - 25% Creativity and Design
 - 50% Informative Display
 - 25% Presentation of the Exhibit

SEARCH FOR MOST OPERATING TEEN CENTER

- 1. The Search for Most Operating Teen Center shall be open to all public secondary schools in the City.
- 2. Submission and confirmation of entry shall be on or before February 18, 2020 through the ASRH section or thru Ms. Edsilyn Salido.
- 3. Once confirmed, the evaluation committee shall visit for an on-site evaluation a week before the actual date of the Festival of Talents. (Exact date of evaluation is to be announced)
- 4. A representative from the participating school will be called for an orientation regarding the search, scheduled date will be announced by the organizer.
- 5. On-site evaluation shall focus on three (3) major categories; (1) Physical Facilities, (2) Services and Operations, and (3) Records and Documentations.
- 6. Criteria for judging:
 - 25% Physical Facilities (i.e separate room for counseling area, Conduciveness, Cabinet and etc.)
 - 50% Services and Operations (i.e programs and activities implemented, process of operation, PopDev initiatives, plans and proposals)
 - 25% Records and Documentations (i.e copies of attendance sheets, narrative reports, project proposal/ calendar of activities, cases and data record on teen-related cases and action taken)
- 7. Winners for Most Operating Teen Center will receive a plaque, cash prize and will be announced during the Festival of Talents.

BEST POPDEV CLUB MODERATOR/ADVISER

- 1. The Search for Best PopDev Club Moderator shall be open to all public secondary schools in the City.
- 2. Submission and confirmation of entry shall be on or before February 18, 2020 through the ASRH section or thru Ms. Edsilyn Salido.
- 3. Once confirmed, the evaluation committee shall visit for an on-site evaluation a week before the actual date of the Festival of Talents. (Exact date of evaluation is to be announced)

 - 25% Services and Intervention Initiative (i.e counseling mechanism, services delivered to the students, problem analysis and intervention, case handling and protocol, trainings and seminars attended)
 - 25% Accomplishment Report (All achievements and accomplishments upon assumption as PopDev Coordinator/Moderator)
 - 25% Linkages and Partnership (i.e resource mobilization, list of partners and
