- 2. All entries in hardcopies shall be indorsed properly by the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) to the personnel in the Learning Resource Management Center (LRMC) on or before March 20, 2020. All entries shall be evaluated and only those commendable entries will be showcased in the said congress.
- 3. The criteria in the evaluation are as follows: (1) learning competencies (LCs)- content is consistent with the targeted LCs intended for the learning area and grade level; (2) instructional design and organization; (3) instructional quality; (4) assessment; (5) intellectual property rights compliance (ex. copyrighted materials used in the IMs are cited, references are properly cited in the bibliography, etc); (6) readability; (7) physical attributes (ex. cover page, front matter pages, inside pages, back matter pages), (8) design and layout; (9) typographical organization; and (10) format (prints, illustrations, design and layout, paper binding, size and weight of learning resource.
- 4. Enclosed are the Instructional Materials (IMs) format, criteria in the evaluation for selecting the best IMs and IMs evaluators for your reference.
