

Greetings!

The Cagayan de Oro Historical and Cultural Commission (HISCOM) has been tasked by the City Government of Cagayan de Oro to promote awareness of our local heritage. Since February 2017, the Commission has been collaborating with the Department of Education – Division of Cagayan de Oro in crafting a learning resource material titled the "Primer on the Local History of Cagayan de Oro". The said resource material was written to help answer the need of DepEd for a reference material which deals with local history of the city, an important segment of the Araling Panlipunan subject. The HISCOM did the researches, collected and organized pertinent data; while a group of DepEd teacher-writers crafted the modules that made up the material. The result is a teacher resource learning material which, in its final edited form, can be used by both elementary and secondary levels.

Since then, the project has progressed into which the First Volume is already nearing into its completion. Once the final process is done, the said Volume 1 module will be ready for printing and publication this summer; and by this school year 2020-2021, the Araling Panlipunan teachers will finally be able to integrate it into their lessons.

Along this line, and for the sake of project continuity, HISCOM hereby announces that it will be conducting a "DOUBLE BLIND PEER REVIEW" for the entire month of March, in which the Commission will tap three (3) experts to check the veracity and authenticity of all compiled modules of Volume 1. In this type of review, the identities of both teacher-writers and reviewers will be kept hidden.

With this, we would like to request the assigned DepEd teacher-writers of Volume 1 to kindly <u>turnover to HISCOM</u> their respective hard copies of their modules this March 03, 2020. Until then, the teacher-writers will be given the time to do their own polishing of their modules. Meanwhile, the City Museum of Cagayan de Oro will serve as the secretariat of this whole project and will be the one to coordinate with both reviewers and teacher-writers all throughout the review process.

Once the DOUBLE BLIND PEER REVIEW process is done, the City Museum secretariat will then hand the modules back to the teacher-writers for them to integrate the reviewers' correction and recommendation for improvement into their soft copies. Afterwhich, HISCOM will be coordinating with **Mr Romeo Aclo** for this project's further steps.

The Commission anticipates that with the final output, the Volume 1 primer will finally be used this coming June of this school year. Hopefully, we will then start the validation of the Volume 2 and the crafting of the Volume 3 within this year.
