

Greetings from CaChET Family!



We wish to invite you for a continued partnership to assist teachers and students in building strong and firm character education in this new normal set-up.

We intend to pursue for the Campaign for the Character Education Tenacity (CACHET) Program this coming school year, 2020-2021, none of which would require in-person presence and as usual, none of which would carry any expense on the part of students, parents and teachers participating.

The objective is to provide an integral program mix from July 2020 to April 2021 to sustain character education development among more than 300 students and teachers who have been energized and activated through a series of communications to them from us during the lockdown. We have been sending them letters, videos, games, quizzes with prizes, that have kept the interest level high among elementary and high school students, as well as teachers and alumni, from some 80 public schools. In the remaining weeks of June, we intend to intensify our contact with them in anticipation of July.

We are looking at 10 interventions monthly for students and teachers, all from the public school system.

 WEEKLY BROADCAST IN RADIO VERITAS, UNDER KATOK TAHANAN (4X A MONTH, EVERY MONDAY)

The Monday show is called *Millennial Monday* because issues dealt with on that day comprise concerns facing young people. Every Monday, from December 2019 to date, CACHET students and alumni have been featured in the program, lasting from 10:30 to 11:45. Prior to the lockdown, four to six public high school students were interviewed in person in the Radio Veritas studio in Quezon City. From the lockdown, the interviews and other parts of the program were carried out either through phone patch or Zoom.

In the coming months, interviews would remain to be via phone patch or Zoom, whichever is called for by the interview topic and the student guests.

2. WEEKLY LETTER TO THE CACHET FAMILY (4X A MONTH, EVERY WEDNESDAY Letter writing was done daily during the entire lockdown. From 22 March to date, we have sent more than 75 letters, with more than 10 written by CACHET students and alumni, and the last 28 comprising notes on values and virtues according to a framework of virtues that CACHET developed. 3. TWICE A MONTH VIRTUAL ASSEMBLY OF STUDENTS AND TEACHERS (2X A MONTH, EVERY 2nd and 4th SATURDAY AFTERNOON, OVER ZOOM OR GOOGLE MEET, AS PER STUDENT AND TEACHER PREFERENCE) Kick-off will be on July 11, 2020 at 2:00 – 4:30pm.

The assembly will comprise quiz bees and mind games; workshop and a short talk on the theme aligned with EsP of DepEd, corresponding to the theme of Katok Tahanan and the weekly letter; and a get-together on personal experiences and other peripheral youth issues.

Your endorsement will surely strengthen the discernment and the determination of students and teachers to give attention to this aspect of the CACHET program. The mood and tone will be similar to what characterized CACHET monthly sessions in-person in the past school years.

ADULT AND PEER MENTORING.

Perhaps the most significant component of the CACHET Program for the year is the continuation of mentoring, albeit on-line. Mentoring remains personal and individual, with the students and even the teachers given all the opportunity to open up with their mentors and be encouraged and helped to make good and responsible decisions on key aspects of their lives.

We do hope you will find the proposed program worth your consideration and the attention of schools, teachers, and principals concerned. CACHET has been a source of encouragement among students and teachers regularly attending its sessions. We are confident that the incoming "new normal" school year will not be any different and would instead give many more opportunities on account of the greater challenges being faced.
