- Committed to enabling all learners to complete quality basic education and in preparation for the opening of the School Year 2020-2021, the Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office X directs all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) to conduct a five-day Dry Run of their Learning Delivery Modalities under Basic Education Learning Continuity Plans (BE LCPs) in Light of the Covid-19 Public Health Emergency on July 27-31.
- As per agreement during the 8th Regional Management Committee Video Conference, the SDOs shall conduct a simulation of one grade level in all learning areas in one school per SDO preferably. The assignment of grade level is the same as those stipulated in Regional Memorandum No. 174, s. 2020 on the Submission of the Curriculum Implementation and Learning Management Matrix. The SDOs shall utilize in the simulation the self-learning modules they have developed, which will also be validated through the attached validation tools.
- The validation tools shall be submitted for analysis to EPS-LRMDS whose observations and suggestions will be incorporated into the learning resources utilized.
