The group composition should include, but are not limited to the following:

- Production Director
- Post Production Manager
- Writer
- Camera Man

The group must delegate a focal person that will represent their team.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES AND MECHANICS

- All interested participants must register and fill up an application form with a short two-paragraph description and initial title of their 1 minute video through this link <a href="https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAlpQLScsvvw_opCPlUkD-J1VNkTTw7_N07TwOwjjG5_fdUwt4LSRUA/viewform?vc=0&c=0&w=1&flr=0
- 2. Only one entry per group is allowed.
- 3. Participants may choose any video treatment, except animation.
- 4. Participants are required to observe minimum health and safety standards during the production of the video.
- 5. Video resolution should be at least 720p (1280x720), 25fps frame rate.
- 6. The 1 Minute Video entry will be sent to the official email of DSWD Sectoral Unit sectoral.dswd10@gmail.com with the subject: 1 Minute Video Challenge
- 7. All entries are subject to initial screening and should not contain any offensive or inappropriate language, image and/or content.

- 8. The videos will be judged in terms of creativity and originality, value of information and relation to advocacy, production and technical quality, and entertainment value. The decision of the judges will be final.
- 9. The length of video entries should have a maximum of 1 minute. One (1) points per 5 seconds will be deducted from entries with more than 1 minute of the required running time.
- 10. One point per day will be deducted for those who will submit after the deadline on November 19, 2021 (5PM).

ONLINE VOTING

For the online voting, all entries will be posted in the DSWD Region X Facebook Page. Voting will be open on November 22-25, 2021. Finalists may promote their respective entries to generate likes or positive reactions that are essential for the People's Choice Award.

The entry with the most number of likes or positive reactions in the DSWD Facebook Page will have the highest points for the People's Choice Award.
