The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development - Special Curricular Programs Division (BCD-SCPD), shall open its application to public secondary school teachers interested to be part of Batch 6 of the **Special Program in Foreign Language-Japanese (SPFL-Japanese) training.** The qualified teachers for **Batch 6** shall undergo three (3) summers and three (3) follow-through trainings from June to March starting in 2022. These includes an intensive language training courses in the Philippines and/or in Japan, including review courses for the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), which shall be conducted by the Japan Foundation, Manila. The benefits of the program provide an avenue to become proficient in Nihongo, an opportunity to study in Japan, and to become a Nihongo translator.

The following are the requirements to be complied with by the teacher-applicant:

- Teacher's qualification must be aligned with DO no. 68, s. 2009
- Letter of Intent to be endorsed by the school principal addressed to the Bureau Director Jocelyn DR Andaya
- Number of Junior High School students interested in the program duly certified by the school principal
- Stable/strong internet connectivity for online training
- Must be 36 years old or below.
