

TEENsights: Adolescent Sexuality and Reproductive Health Insights

Mechanics for the Pre-Test/Post-Test POPDEV QUIZ Competition:

- 1. Participants must be grade 9, 10, 11 and 12 from public secondary high schools.
- Participants must fill up pre-registration form link: shorturl.at/gCHMT starting November 17, 2021
- 3. The Pre/Post Test is required to all participants.
- 4. Pre-test will be open at 9:00am until 10:00am on November 29, 2021.
- 5. Post-test will be open right after the episodes on November 29, 2021.
- 6. Link of pre-test and post-test will be posted on the video description.
- Participants are requested to join the AHD CDO HIGH Schools Facebook Group and LIKE the ORO YOUTH CENTER Facebook page.
- 8. Scoring:
 - a. 80% average score of Post-test
 - b. 20% rate of takers (total number of grade 9, 10, 11 & 12 student takers/total number of students enrolled on the said grade level)
 - c. 100% total score
- 9. Top 5 highest total score will be declared as winners
- 10. Winning School will receive: To be announce
- 11. Participants must share their insights at the comment section. Our team will determine 24 winners of care packages worth 500 pesos each.
- 12. All participants are expected to share and participate during the live stream of TEENsights.
