- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), announces the Call for Submission of Professional Development Programs and Course Proposals for Public School Teachers and School Leaders for DepEd Service Providers. This is in line with DepEd Order No. 1, s. 2021 titled Guidelines for NEAP Recognition of Professional Development Programs and Course for Teachers and School Leaders.
- The call is open for Schools Division Office (SDOs) that seek to offer Professional Development Programs and Courses for Teachers and School Leaders.
- 3. The SDOs shall submit their proposals to NEAP R10 at neap.region10.gov.ph for evaluation
- 4. The porposals shall be evaluated based on the following criteria as stated in D.O. 001. S. 2020:
  - a. Align with NEAP Professional Development Priorities as staetd in DepEd Memorandum No. 050, s. 2020;

- Mapping of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST)
   Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (PPSSH) or the Philippine Professional Standards for School Supervisors (PPSS);
- c. Articulation of Objectives/outcomes;
- d. Alignment of the Objectives/Intended Learning Outcomes (ILOs), Content and if applicable, Assessment with the Professional Standards for teachers and school leaders:
- e. Soundness of Methodology;
- f. Mechanism to determine whether or not the objectives/ILOs have been met;
- g. Strength on Research-base;
- h. Use of Adult Learning Principles;
- i. Use of Recognized Best Practices;
- j. Intended Level Classroom Application and Innovation;
- k. Credentials, Expertise of Resource Person/s; and
- I. Budget and Costing and Absoprtive Capacity.
- 5. The DSP proposal may include a request for budget support from the Human Resource Development fund.
