#### Dear Director Bayocot:

Greetings from Save the Children Philippines (SCP)!

We are the world's leading independent children's organization and we have been working in the Philippines for the past 40 years - protecting children in need, saving children in emergencies, speaking up for children's rights, and ensuring better lives for all Filipino children and across the world. Save the Children globally and in the Philippines has long been in the forefront of advocating for the rights and protection of all Filipino children across all contexts, in the home, school, and the community. Through our work with the Department of Education, we endeavoured to support the creation of a safe and conducive school environment where all children, including the most marginalized of learners, fully develop and gain important life skills.

One of our key projects this year is the creation of a tool to determine the functionality of existing child protection mechanisms. We have sought the services of consultants – Ari Regino and Niño Lasin – to conduct this project, which will be crucial in the monitoring of child protection measures and in the scaling up of child protection programs across all regions and divisions.

More specifically, the project aims to do the following:

- Identify and recommend a draft framework for a CP Mechanisms Assessment Tool;
- Collect insights on the following key questions from rights-holders and duty bearers relevant to child protection mechanisms; and
- Develop a preliminary iteration (skeletal) of a work-in-progress prototype for assessing functionality of child protection mechanisms in barangays and schools.

The project will gather data from children, parents, teachers and educators, and community leaders and members. The tool will be co-designed and co-developed together with these stakeholders, in order to flesh out issues in implementation and solicit practical solutions to challenges encountered in the field.

Thus, the researchers will be conducting a series of online Focus Group Discussions (FGDs) on January 19-25, 2021, together with the identified stakeholders from Region 10. We are requesting for the support and assistance of DepEd Region 10 in mobilizing the necessary number of stakeholders to attend the discussions. The required number of participants are as follows:

15 parents and 15 children, aged 9 years old and above;

• 25 student leaders from both elementary and secondary levels and 25 Alternative Learning System learners;

20 teachers and school personnel; and

20 local community/barangay leaders and stakeholders of the Department of Education; and

• 20 partner service providers, including the local enforcement, social workers, and non-government organization leaders and community mobilizers.
