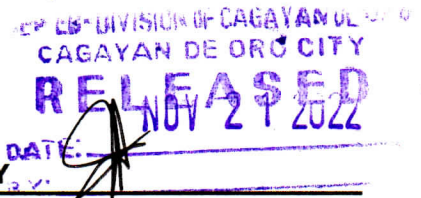

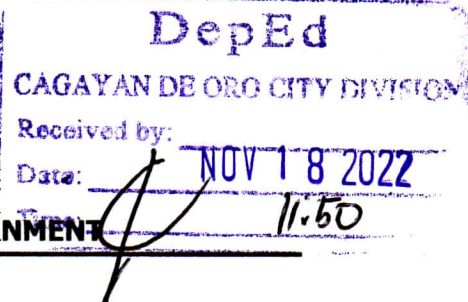

A PROJECT PROPOSAL

On the Celebration of 2022 National Students' Day

A Project Proposed by the Division Federated Supreme Student Government

November 15, 2022

I. Rationale of the Project

After the memorable celebration of the World Teachers' Month on October, now we have come to another: the 2022 National Students' Day. This celebration will showcase the creative prowess, innovation, and talents of our students through varied activities that will further their abilities. The upcoming event will be of meaningful time for our learners to show what have they got and the competence that was molded by our teachers, thus, demonstrating their part as the "voice of change" as what this year's Students' Day theme resonates.

In accordance to DepEd Memorandum dated September 13, the education department laid out general provisions in the celebration of the 2022 National Students' Day with the theme, *"Ikaw, Ako, Tayo: Bahagi ng Proseso, Boses ng Pagbabago."*

This event aims to amplify the "valuable contribution and the collective manifestation of learners to achieve positive change, and provide a learner-centered platform to engage and mobilize learners with various backgrounds in participating in the different carefully designed interactive and participatory activities that promote upskilling, high sense of social responsibility, acceptance, and respect of differences."

As the celebration fast approaches, the Division Federated Supreme Student Government (DFSSG) is proposing this online event-project embedded with values-oriented activities. The following presents the flow, processes, and resources the event requires for a fulfilled and successful conduct of this division-based Students' Day Celebration.

Person/s Involved: Students from different Schools in the Division of Cagayan de Oro

Legal Basis: Republic Act No. 11369, the National Students' Day Act

II. Proposed Activities

2022 DFSSG Students' Day Celebration

November 20, 2022

General Mechanics:

1. The contest is open to all bona fide High School students coming from different Secondary Schools in the Division of Cagayan de Oro.
2. The Schools may only have one (1) participant for each category at most. A particular student can only participate to one (1) category at a time.
3. SSG Presidents are not allowed to join the contests.
4. The participants should submit their entry on or before November 24 at 8:00 PM through this email address: michaelanthonyallosada5956@gmail.com
5. Judging and deliberation will be on November 25, 2022.
6. Announcement of winners will be on November 26 at 6:30-8:30 PM and will be posted through the Division Federated Supreme Student Government Facebook Page.
7. The participation of participants in this activity is monitored and voluntary.

I. POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

Poster Making	To showcase and express their talents, feelings, and views of the world around them while spreading awareness about the given theme ahead	November 24 (8:00 PM) – Submission of entries to the provided email. November 25 – Judging of entries. November 26 (4:30 PM) – Posting of entries via the DFSSG FB Page.

MECHANICS:

- Each school may only have one (1) representative at most.
- The poster must be made on a ¼ illustration board, self-provided by the participants including the art materials to be used.
- The output must be connected to the theme, *"Ikaw, Ako, Tayo: Bahagi ng Proseso at Boses ng Pagbabago"*.
- Participants must submit a clear photo of their poster-making output to the email provided.

MECHANICS:

- Each school may only have one (1) representative at most.
- The piece must be originally composed relating to the theme, *"Ikaw, Ako, Tayo: Bahagi ng Proseso at Boses ng Pagbabago"*.
- The participant may use English or Filipino medium for his/her piece.
- The contestants must submit a video output of their performances to this email address to the email provided.

- Each school may only have one (1) representative at most.
- Contestants are free to choose their desired song choice.
- The contestants must submit a 3-5 minute video output of their performances to the email address provided.


