ALCARAZ STORY". The film tells the story about the tragic but very heroic death of a brave Scout and Junior Forest Ranger, Oscar M. Alcaraz, then a student of the Eulogio Rodriguez Jr. High School. On August 30, 1970 (Sunday and National Heroes' Day), Oscar M. Alcaraz lost his life in saving his scout master, but he did not die in vain because he gave his life so that others may live. In recognition of his gallantry and heroism, he was conferred the Gold Medal of Honor by the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, the Presidential Medal of Merit posthumously by President Ferdinand E. Marcos in a solemn and touching ceremony at the Malacañan Palace on September 11, 1970 and also by virtue of an Administrative Order his body was ordered transferred and the first civilian to be interred at the Libingan
