DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT'S CONDUCT OF 'BATANG MALAYA' EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING, ORATORICAL SPEECH, AND POSTER MAKING COMPETITIONSAMONG PUBLIC AND PRIVATE JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH STUDENTS

The Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) X invites all Junior and Senior High students to join the 'Batang Malaya' Extemporaneous Speaking, Oratorical Speech, and Poster making Competitions on November 30, 2023, Thursday, 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. at SM CDO Downtown, CM Recto Avenue, Cagayan de Oro City in celebration of the 2023 National Children's Month with the theme, "Healthy, nourished, sheltered: Ensuring the right to life for all".

Said competitions put a spotlight on the importance of the children's healthcare, nutrition, shelter, and acceptable work conditions to achieve a labor-free Philippines while giving them the necessary protections on their civil, political, economic, social, health and cultural rights.

Registration forms shall be emailed to dole10.tssdx@gmail.com on or before November 27, 2023.

Relative to the aforesaid activity, all public and private Junior and Senior High School students of Cagayan de Oro City are invited to join the competitions.

Participation in this activity shall be on a voluntary basis. As such, participants themselves shall shoulder any registration fees and travel/incidental expenses. Further, their participation shall be subject to the non-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith", Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 (Policy on Contributions), and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 (Policy on Off-Campus Activities).

CONCEPT PAPER

"Batang Malaya" Extemporaneous Speaking, Oratorical Speech, and Poster Making Competitions

1. RATIONALE

Batang Malaya is a campaign that the National Council Against Child Labor (NCACL) and its partners embark on in pursuit of a child labor-free Philippines.

These Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) X competitions are initiated by the Regional Office in coordination with its Regional Child Labor Council, Regional Tripartite Industrial Peace Council-Northern Mindanao, Northern Mindanao Federation of Family Welfare Committees, nongovernment organizations, civil society organizations, workers' organizations and other social partners at the local and national levels on its anti-child labor campaign of the National Child Labor Committee's (NCLC) to streamline the NCLC's "Isang Milyong Batang Malaya Campaign Against Child Labor".

Under the Philippine Development Plan for 2017-2022, Philippines committed to reduce 30% (or 630,000) of the 2.1 million child labor cases and accomplish a total of one (1) million children removed from child labor by 2025 or 53,739 from Northern Mindanao region.

Under DOLE AO No. 579, the Regional and Provincial Offices shall develop Information and Education Campaign materials, and other related activities in the implementation of Child Labor Prevention and Elimination Program (CLPEP).

To promote this program through awareness raising, "Batang Malaya" Extemporaneous Speaking, Oratorical Speech, and Poster Making Competitions are hereby conceptualized in order to maximize information to be participated by Junior, and Senior High Schools in Northern Mindanao.

11. **OBJECTIVES**

- A. Encourage and develop public speaking skills, creativity and artistic talents among public/private Junior and High School students of Northern Mindanao;
- B. Provide an opportunity for their exposure at a young age;
- C. Raise anti-child labor awareness and appreciation of the government's interventions against the social issue; and
- D. Recognize excellence among the students in relation to the implementation of DOLE's Child Labor Prevention and Elimination Program.

EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING CONTEST MECHANICS, RULES, III. **CRITERIA AND PRIZES:**

- A. The competition is open and FREE of registration to all currently-enrolled Junior High School students from private and public schools/universities within Northern Mindanao:
- A. Proof of enrolment shall be submitted to the secretariat on the competition
- B. Contest piece should be in English;
- C. There will only be one (1) representative per school/university;

- D. The topic shall be about child labor in Northern Mindanao, "Batang Malaya", or Child Labor-Free Philippines in form of #Hashtags that shall be given, through draw lots prior to the start of the competition;
- E. The contestant shall deliver his/her piece while standing;
- F. Each contestant shall be given one (1) minute to compose his/her idea, and five (5) minutes to deliver the assigned-pre-drawn #hashtag;
- G. The contestants are not allowed to have any gadget during the competition;
- H. A timer accessible to the contestant, judges and audience shall be provided by the Secretariat;
- There will be a 1-point deduction for every 30-second overtime from the respective judges' total score before determining the rank of the contestants;
- J. The style of the delivery shall be conversational, oratorical or a combination of both:
- K. Dramatic style is considered discouraged;
- L. The contestant should wear his/her school uniform for identification;
- M. Use of paper, pen, sound effects, and props for this purpose is disallowed;
- N. Three consecutive bell rings shall serve as a warning for the last minute of delivery:
- O. DOLE-X shall not be responsible of accommodation, meals, and travel expenses for participants. However, snacks and lunch during the competition shall be provided;
- P. Competition date shall be on November 30, 2023, Thursday, 9:00AM-12:00NN at SM CDO Downtown;
- Q. Registration form is hereby attached and shall be emailed to dole10.tssdx@gmail.com on or before 17 November 2023;
- R. After the deliberation of the members of the board of judges, the judges' decision is final.

- B. Proof of enrolment shall be submitted to the secretariat on the competition day:
- C. Contest piece should be in English;
- D. There will only be one (1) representative per school/university;
- E. The topic shall highlight the 2023 World Day Against Child Labor theme "Social Justice for All. End Child Labour!" set by the International Labour Organization;
- F. The contestant shall deliver his/her piece while standing;
- G. Each contestant shall only be given one (1) minute to compose his/her idea and five (5) minutes to deliver the speech;
- H. The contestants are not allowed to have any gadget during the competition;
- A timer accessible to the contestant, judges and audience shall be provided by the Secretariat;
- J. There will be a 1-point deduction for every 30-second overtime from the respective judges' total score before determining the rank of the contestants;
- K. The style of the delivery shall be oratorical. Dramatic style is discouraged;
- L. The contestant should wear his/her school uniform for identification;
- M. Use of paper, pen, sound effects, and props for this purpose is disallowed;
- N. Three consecutive bell rings shall serve as a warning for the last minute of delivery;
- O. DOLE-X shall not be responsible of accommodation, meals, and travel expenses for participants. However, snacks and lunch during the competition shall be provided;
- P. Microphone shall be automatically muted when his/her time is up;
- Q. Competition date shall be on November 30, 2023, Thursday, 1:30PM-4:00PM at SM CDO Downtown;


