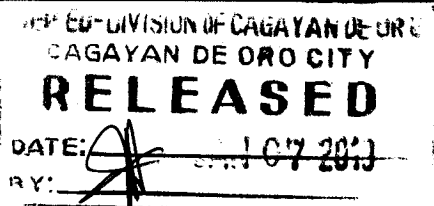

**OFFICIAL DELEGATES FOR THE 2019 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS
CONFERENCE (NSPC), PDOS, TRAVEL ADVISORY
AND ENHANCEMENT ACTIVITY**

1. In accordance with Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, also known as the *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, and in compliance with DepEd Memorandum No. 167, s. 2018, delegates from this Region for the 2019 National Schools Press Conference in Lingayen, Pangasinan, from January 28 to February 1, 2019, are listed in the enclosure.

2. The delegates found in Enclosure 1 comprise the 49 NSPC qualifiers, coaches, journalism coordinators, identified NSPC finalists of the School Paper Category and campus journalists (CJs), contestants for column writing in both elementary and secondary levels. Enclosure 2 is the list of official delegates of the 2019 NSPC.

3. Each public and private school participant included in Enclosure 1 shall pay a registration fee of **Four Thousand Pesos (P 4,000.00)** per DepEd Memorandum No. 197, s. 2018. Subject to the approval of the 2019 National Budget, the registration fee of official delegates shall be reimbursed by division to be downloaded by DepEd Central Office. The registration fee shall cover the costs of board and lodging, kits (including conference materials), rental of equipment/vehicles, payment of utilities, contingency and other related expenses to be incurred in the conduct of NSPC. Advance payment in checks shall be addressed to the host schools division office (SDO) of Pangasinan 1 at **Land Bank - Lingayen Branch** with **Account Number 2422 - 1038 - 32**, Account Name: **DepEd Division Office** on or before **January 10, 2019** while onsite payment shall be paid in cash.

4. All CDOC delegates are advised to attend the **Enhancement Training for the 2019 NSPC Qualifiers** on January 16-19, 2018 in a venue to be announced in a separate memorandum.

5. There will be a Pre Departure Orientation Seminar on January 22, 2019 at Fr. William F. Masterson SJ ES at 8:00 am to 5:00 Pm, Departure from Cagayan de Oro City to Clark Pampanga will be on January 23-24, 2019 and **Journalism Champions' Workout** in Lingayen, Pangasinan, on January 25-26. Failure to

6. The school paper advisers who are finalist in the school paper category will secure their own accommodation in the entire duration of the NSPC.

Travel expenses, registration fees, and other expenses shall be charged against the schools' Maintenance and/or Other Operating Expenses/local/regional funds, Special Education Fund, or the School Campus Journalism funds, whichever is applicable, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
