# PAKIGSANGKA 3.0: PICHE-CDO Inter-Senior High School Quiz Bee September 19, 2019 | 1PM - 4PM | Limketkal Mall Activity Center

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- The competition is organized by the Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers Cagayan de Oro (PIChE-CDO) Chapter as part of the annual ChE Week celebration.
- The competition is open to all bonafide senior high schools in the province of Misamis Oriental under the General Academic track – SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING and MATHEMATICS (STEM) strand.
- Each participating SHS will have a total of three (3) participants of either of the following combinations:
  - a. 3 Grade 11 students
  - b. 3 Grade 12 students
  - c. 2 Grade 11 students and 1 Grade 12 student
  - d. 2 Grade 12 students and 1 Grade 11 student

They must present their validated student ID cards and/or registration forms during the competition day upon registration.

- The competition will cover specialization subjects (General Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, and Biology) and will touch trivial questions related to Chemical Engineering.

Should there be substitution(s) on the day of competition due to absence or unavailability of the confirmed contestant(s), the school should inform the organizers as soon as possible to avoid disqualifications. Substitutions once the quiz bowl has started will not be allowed.

#### RULES OF ENGAGEMENT:

- The competition will be divided into three (3) rounds. Each round is composed of twenty (20) questions for the easy round, fifteen (15) for the average round, and ten (10) for the difficult round.
- In each round, the questions provided are time-limited depending on its difficulty. Easy questions are answerable for 15 seconds. Average questions are time bounded at 30 seconds and lastly, difficult questions will be answered for 1 minute.
- Corresponding points are given depending on its difficulty. An easy question is worth 1
  point. Average question is worth 3 points and a difficult question is worth 5 points each.
- For the first two rounds, 5-second bonus questions are inserted in the middle of the competition. Each question is worth 1 point and will add up to the total points of the participant for that specific round.
- No coaching from the audience is allowed.
- 6. No calculators are allowed during the contest proper.
- 7. Answers shall be submitted with relevant units of measure.

- All answers for any problem-solving questions must be rounded off to two decimal places only. Rules for rounding off: 22.521 becomes 22.52, 22.525 becomes 22.52, and 22.527 becomes 22.53.
- The time limit shall start and the contestants may start answering after the question has been read twice and the quiz master declares "Time starts now".
- 10. The contestants shall stop once "Time's up!" is declared. Contestants will directly raise their answer boards after the "Time's up!" is declared. No answer shall be accepted once the time limit has expired and answer has been shown.
- 11. After all teams have raised their answers, the correct answer to the question will be projected on the screen and read by the quizmaster for the information of the teams and the audience. An official scorer shall monitor which teams get the correct answers.
- 12. The contestant, their teammate, or their coach may raise protests. However, protests against the current question shall only be heard before the next question is read.
- 13. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and binding.
- 14. The top three teams in the final round will be declared as the 2019 PAKIGSANGKA: PIChE-CDO Inter-Senior High School Quiz Bee winners and will receive trophies, medals and cash prizes.
- 15. The Quiz Bowl organizers reserve the right to eject any participant or member of the audience who they believe is detrimental to the orderly conduct of the contest.
- 16. Technical protests be raised prior to start of quiz bowl proper. The protests accepted during quiz bowl be limited to the questions.
