

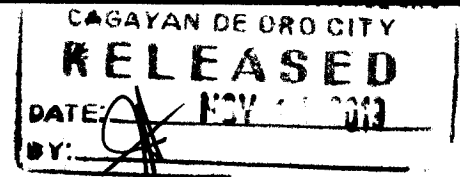

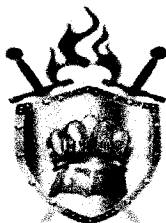

PROCLAMATION NO. 479

DECLARING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS FILIPINO
VALUES MONTH

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 62, dated September 30, 1992, declared a Moral Recovery Program in response to the need to strengthen the moral resources of the Filipino rooted in Filipino culture, values and ideals that are pro-God, pro-people, pro-country, and pro-nature, and thereby mobilizing all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in our daily lives as citizens and to awaken us all to the power of these values in achieving our individual and national goals;

WHEREAS, the promotion and engendering of a sustained Moral Recovery Program may be further facilitated through a vigorous and coordinated campaign measures actively participated in by all sectors of Filipino society;

WHEREAS, the celebration of Filipino Values Month, on a regular basis is a desirable and effective measure to create moral awakening and national consciousness on human values that are unique, genuine and positively Filipino.

NOW, THEREFOR, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the month of November of every year as "Filipino Values Month" under the auspices of the Kabisig People Movement. Filipinos of all ages and from all sectors of our society are hereby enjoined to actively participate in the observance thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 7th day of October, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and ninety-four.

NATIONAL BUDGET CIRCULAR

No. 563
April 22, 2016

TO : ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS, OFFICES AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCS); GOVERNMENT -OWNED OR -CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS (GOCCS); LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGUS); AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

Subject : **Guidelines on Participation of Government Officials and Employees in Conventions, Seminars, Conferences, Symposia and Similar Non-Training Gatherings Sponsored by Non-Government Organizations or Private Institutions**

1.0 **Purpose**

This Circular is being issued to update the guidelines and the allowable cost of participation of government officials and employees in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia, and other similar gatherings, prescribed under National Budget Circular (NBC) No. 442 dated March 29, 1992 and NBC No. 486 dated March 26, 2003.

2.0 **Coverage**

- 2.1 This Circular shall cover all activities requiring the payment of registration and related fees pertaining to the participation of government officials/employees in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia, and other similar gatherings conducted/sponsored by non-government organizations or private institutions in the Philippines.
- 2.2 For purposes of this Circular, conventions, seminars and the like shall refer to those conducted basically for purposes of sharing, discussing or disseminating ideas or information on the developments in a particular field or fields of interest and/or for common appreciation and resolution of certain issues. It includes, but is not limited to, those conducted by professional organizations or groups of common interest where government employees are members. It excludes those conducted for training purposes where participants are expected to gain or strengthen skills and technical or management expertise in their areas of endeavor.

Lines

- 3.1 Government officials and employees may be authorized to participate in conventions, seminars, conferences, symposia and such other activities conducted by non-government organizations or private institutions for a fee, as part of the human resource development program of the government, chargeable against government funds.
- 3.2 The registration or participation fee in said convention, seminar, etc. shall not exceed P 2,000 per day for each participant.
- 3.3 In cases where the convention is held out-of-town, authorized participants may be entitled to travel expenses and allowances as authorized under existing rules and regulations.
- 3.4 Membership and similar fees paid for personal or individual membership in a private organization shall be for the account of the member concerned and shall not be charged to government funds. On the other hand, institutional membership fees, i.e., agency membership may be charged to government funds.
- 3.5 As far as practicable, government officials and employees should avail of the early registration rates to avail of reduced costs of participation in conventions, seminars, conferences and the like.
- 3.6 All expenditures for the purpose shall be subject to the usual budgeting and accounting rules and regulations.

4.0 **Responsibility of Agency Heads**

Agency Heads shall be responsible for the implementation of the provisions of this Circular in their respective offices.

5.0 **Repealing Clause**

All other circulars and issuances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with this Circular are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

6.0 **Effectivity**

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
