

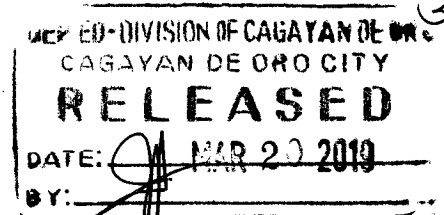

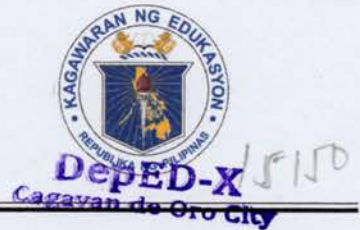

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization - Regional Language Center (SEAMEO RELC) is offering the SEAMEO RELC scholarship for the 2019 Certificate in English Language Teaching- Secondary (CELT-S) program which will run from 22 July 2019 to February 2020.

The program is designed by Cambridge Assessment English (CAE) for in-service teachers of English working in secondary school settings. SEAMEO RELC has collaborated with CAE to offer a blended learning course that incorporates formal assessment, leading to the CELT-S qualification.

SEAMEO will cover the registration and tuition fees for the entire program, as well as the subsistence allowance, airfare and accommodation cost for the period of residential stay at RELC. The other details of the program are enclosed in the attached Terms and Conditions of Program Participation.

Teacher-applicants should submit their documents to the SGOD-HRD unit of their respective divisions, with the endorsement from their school head.

Each region is advised to send in four (4) nominees. 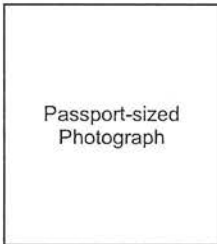
