

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

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization - Regional Language Center (SEAMEO RELC) is offering the SEAMEO RELC scholarship for the 2019 Certificate in English Language Teaching- Secondary (CELT-S) program which will run from 22 July 2019 to February 2020.

The program is designed by Cambridge Assessment English (CA!) for in-service teachers of English working in secondary school settings. SEAMEO RELC has collaborated with CAE to offer a blended learning course that incorporates formal assessment, leading to the CELT-S qualification.

SEAMEO will cover the registration and tuition fees for the entire program, as well as the subsistence allowance, airfare and accommodation cost for the period of residential stay at RELC. The other details of the program are enclosed in the attac ed Terms and Conditions of Program Participation.

Teacher-applicants should submit their documents to the SGOD-HRD unit of their respective divisions, with the endorsement from their school head.

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

What is CELT-S?	<i>CELT-S</i> is a qualification designed for English language teachers working in secondary education (ages 11-18).
What are the aims of CELT-S?	 CELT-S aims to help participants improve the quality of their classroom practice by: developing and extending teachers' knowledge and skills; focusing on the strategies, methods and materials teachers need to teach language effectively; helping teachers to manage and motivate large classes; and providing teachers with strategies to ensure that all learners achieve their potential.
How will CELT-S be conducted?	<i>CELT-S</i> is a 150-hour blended learning course, comprising eight modules (see Course Syllabus for details) and a practical component (comprising portfolio tasks and teaching observations).
What is the timeframe and nature of the course?	 CELT-S will be conducted in four phases. They are: <u>Phase 1: 22 July to 3 November 2019 (60 hours)</u> Orientation Webinars

	 <u>Phase 4: TP2 and TP3 (final assessment)</u> <u>Tentative dates</u> (to be confirmed with hosting schools of the participants) 29 January to 5 February 2020 or 5 February to 12 February 2020 or 12 February to 19 February 2020 1-week on-site visit and teaching practice observation (*TP2 & *TP3) by RELC trainer
How will the course participants be assessed?	 The course completion and assessment requirements are: (1) Methodology Completion of the eight modules and progress tests A multiple-choice teaching knowledge test (TKT Module 1) to be taken at RELC, an authorized test centre in Phase 2 (22 November 2019) (2) Teaching practice Completion of portfolio tasks Teaching Practice observation (to be conducted in Phase 4 on-site visit by RELC trainer)
What will the participants receive at the end of the course?	Course participants who complete all the modules and assessments will receive the <i>CELT-S</i> qualification from Cambridge Assessment English, a Certificate for TKT (Module 1) and a Certificate of Achievement from SEAMEO RELC. The <i>CELT-S</i> qualification is awarded with a Pass or Pass with Merit.
