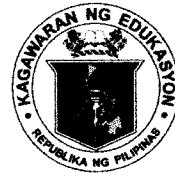
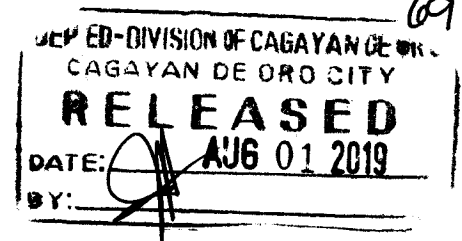

**Design For Change (DFC)** is a global movement that cultivates the I CAN mindset in every child through the design thinking process. Through our school programmes, teachers, principals and volunteers empower learners to take action on issues and submit their stories of change into the **I CAN School Challenge**. They then stand a chance to represent their country at the annual Be The Change (BTC) conference.

Last year (November, 2018), three students from the Philippines was chosen to participate on the said annual Be the Change Conference in Taiwan. These young students were able to present their community and school project in Taiwan as youth ambassadors representing the country. This year, DFC is holding the first **I CAN Childrens' Global Summit at the Vatican in Rome**, November 27th - 30th.

Due to the observable support and candor of Filipino educators in empowering the Filipino children, we propose to expand our growing movement and advocacy to schools and teachers in the Division of Cagayan de Oro City through conducting a training-workshop powered by eduSOIL.

eduSOIL, a DFC licence holder, initiate and provide three (3) Changemaker programmes for teachers and learners with a blended learning approach:

- a. Free Changemaker Starter Pack (online)
- b. 1 day Changemaker Catalyst Lab (online/in-person)
- c. 2 month Changemaker Accelerator Course (online/onsite)

The training aims to empower **schools and teachers** across the Division of Cagayan de Oro City. This being said, we are now requesting your office's endorsement and support for the training-workshop on design thinking for changemakers. ### **Background and Purpose**

#### **PROGRAM BACKGROUND:**

**In the face of global challenges in education and youth empowerment, Design For Change (DFC) is a global movement that cultivates the I CAN mindset in every child with a simple 4 step framework.**

Founded by Kiran Bir Sethi in 2009, DFC has since empowered 2 million children and 76,000 teachers to lead 31,000 stories of change that address a range of global issues.

#### **.PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

With DFC's Design Thinking, project-based learning and 21st century skill development focus, DFC is now present in +65 countries, has received multiple awards and is endorsed by the Harvard School of Education and UN Sustainable Development Goals.

The program is brought to the Philippines by eduSOIL, a hybrid social enterprise, providing Mindfulness, Yoga and Changemaker training and tools to address mental, emotional, physical and social challenges affecting learners and teachers. As a DFC licence holder, eduSOIL provides 3 Changemaker programmes for learners, teachers, corporate and individual volunteers with a blended learning approach:

Free Changemaker Starter Pack (online)

1 day Changemaker Catalyst Lab (online/in-person)

2 month Changemaker Accelerator Course (online/onsite)

eduSOIL provides online training modules for volunteers and teachers participating in:

- Self-guided Changemaker Starter programmes
- **In-person 1 day Changemaker Catalyst Labs OR Online Changemaker Catalyst Courses**
- Onsite 2 month Changemaker Accelerator Programmes with online coaching

Through these programmes, teachers, principals and volunteers empower learners to take action on issues and submit their stories of change into the I CAN School Challenge. They then stand a chance to represent their country at the annual Be The Change conference. ### Goal

- To enable children to lead change in their own communities and find opportunities for change.
- To provide teachers with a framework of design in supporting the children leading change in their own communities

### Objectives and Learning Outcomes

**Objectives:** At the end of the workshop, teachers will be able to:

1. Actively perform activities on the workshop
2. Demonstrate knowledge and commitment on the FIDS Process through creating a changemaker pitch
3. Create a program action plan applicable to their respective schools

### Learning Outcomes

1. Learners and teachers experience Design Thinking to address issues in their community that bother them.
2. Learners and teachers will create a changemaker pitch as a statement of commitment

#### C. Online Changemaker Training

Programme Management: Coordinating with school principals, youth, EV's to establish schedules, monitor progress and conduct programme assessment.

- Self-guided Changemaker Starter programmes
- Onsite 2 month Changemaker Accelerator Programmes with online coaching

### Scope and Limitations



#### SCOPE:

- One-day changemaker catalyst lab facilitated by Design for Change
- Open to 50 teachers from both public and private basic education schools (primary and secondary) in Cagayan de Oro City
- Design for Change Philippines will provide the costings for the following:
  - Toolkits and learning kits to be used at the workshops
  - Food and refreshments
  - Training and facilitation

#### LIMITATIONS:

- The selection of teachers (Eduheroes) are upon the endorsement of the respective school heads and/or principals

### Assumptions and Risks

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- Partners will help accomplish the following logistical requirements to run the event
  - Endorsement from the DepEd Division Office
  - Permit to recommend and utilize an event venue (venue with stable internet connection is preferred)
  - Promotion of the event (within and outside of Social Media)
- Partners will help facilitate the confirmation of attendees

#### RISKS:

- Other school events may overlap with the workshop that might result to low-prioritization over the event (lower attendance turn-out); partners must schedule it depending on the school calendar of activities and availability of teachers
- Unforeseen events such as climatic disruptions may interrupt the event

#### Criteria for Selecting (potential) Changemakers:

Teachers who are qualified on the program should have the following characteristics:

1. **Committed:** Teachers who have strong will and power to achieve and sustain a project
  - a. Club Advisers
  - b. SPG Advisers
  - c. Campus Journalism Advisers
  - d. Young teachers with high potential to lead
2. **Visionaries:** Teachers who believe in the power of students to be empowered and be the change
  - a. Indicators: high student passing rate, implements innovative ideas inside and outside the classroom
3. **Positive Social Esteem and Team Players:** Teacher-leaders who can mobilize teams
