DokyuBata 2019 A Video Documentary Contest

I. OBJECTIVES

DokyuBata encourahes the production of child-friendly television documentary, guided by a specific theme annually. Specifically, it aims to:

- 1. Provide an avenue where aspiring young television documentarists can
- 2. Raise awareness on the value and necessity of child-friendly television content and highlight the feasibility of producing quality programs;
- 3. Encourage children and the youth to promulgate meaningful television content by exposing them to quality documentaries; and
- 4. Promote child participation on pressing issues that directly affect their

II. DOKYUBATA 2019 THEME

The participants' documentary entries must focus on children's "Food and Nutrition" but may work around with the following factors relating to the theme, but

- 1. Filipino culture, tradition, and beliefs on food and nutrition
- 2. National and local policies on food and nutrition
- 3. Food and water safety
- 4. Food supply
- 5. Media usage, food, and nutrition
- 6. Dietary patterns
- 7. Demography and geography (related to food and nutrition)

III. ELIGIBILITY

- A. DokyuBata 2019 Video Documentary Contest is open to Filipino citizen ages 12 to 17 for Children Division and ages 18 to 23 for Young Adult Division.
- B. The production team must be composed of maximum of 10 members who may or may not belong to the same school, barangay, or organization.
- C. Participants are welcome to join the competition individually.

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IV. COMPETITION PERIOD

The period for the submission of entries is from August 19, 2019 to October 18, 2019. The deadline for the submission of entries is on October 18, 2019 at 11:59PM. Entries to be submitted beyond the indicated deadline will no longer be considered.

V. SELECTION

A. Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

•	Content/Adherence to the Theme	30 points
	Originality and Creativity	25 points
•	Production Quality	25 points
•	Overall Impact	20 points

- B. A screening committee composed of the NCCT Secretariat and other qualified judges shall narrow down the entries into the Top 10 for both categories to be featured during the screening and awarding in November 2019.
- C. A board of judges that includes, but not be limited to, professional media practitioners and child's rights and nutrition advocates, shall determine the winners from among the finalists. Their decision is final and irrevocable.
- D. Finalists will be notified via telephone or mobile call/text and electronic mail. An official announcement will also be made on the official Facebook page of the National Council for Children's Television (fb.com/NCCT.DepEd).

- B. Top 10 entries will be featured during the DokyuBata 2019 Awarding Ceremony to be held in November 2019.
- C. Certificates of Recognition will be given to every production team member and the supervising adult of all finalists.

VII. REQUIREMENTS AND MECHANICS

A. General Requirements

- 1. Use of copyrighted material is strictly prohibited. Participants will be liable for any claim of infringement related to the materials included in the entry.
- 2. Entries must be in a documentary genre, facts based.
- 3. Entries must revolve around children's food and nutrition.
- 4. Entries must not shorter than 3 minutes and not longer than 5 minutes for Children Division and 6 to 10 minutes for the Young Adult Division. (This includes Opening billboard and Closing credits. Please follow the required credits format at the end of the document.)
- The production team does not include the cast of actors.
- 6. The production team of the Children Division entries must have at least one supervising adult (e.g. parent, faculty member, barangay official/employee, organization officer), a person of legal age whose role would be limited to logistical guidance (i.e., chaperone, minimal technical help, and guarantor of output's authenticity and compliance to fair use and copyright guidelines.) However, minimal supervision from adults is requested in all stages of production so that the outputs may reflect genuine talent, skills, and worldview of the participants.
 - 7. No promotion or opposition of any product, person, service, or political beliefs.
 - 8. Content must be child-friendly. Please see Appendix for the criteria of a child-friendly content or visit NCCT website for more details.
 - 9. Participant/s can only submit one entry.

B. Audio and Video Requirements

- 1. Must have the minimum resolution of 720x480.
- 2. Videos must feature live footage and may or may not have dialogues or host.
- Dialogues in the videos may be in any vernacular; English subtitles however must be provided when the spoken language in the video is neither English nor Filipino.
- 4. The use of music or musical score is not required. Should it be deemed essential, music or musical score used in the video must be original (i.e., composition of the production team), or royalty free music with proper citation in the credits.
- No logo or watermark of any editing software shall be visible in the video.

VIII. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. Participants warrant that they have read, understood, and agreed to abide the rules and regulations of DokyuBata.
- B. Entries to be included as finalists will become the property of both the National Council for Children's Television and the producers/participants.
- C. The Participants hereby grant NCCT the right to copy, edit and use the materials for educational and informational purposes in perpetuity.
- D. The owners cannot use or publish the materials until the Screening and Awarding ceremonies. The Finalists can be shown to the owners' personal websites, blogs, social media accounts, provided that NCCT and DokyuBata's logos are present.
- E. NCCT reserves the right to amend the rules and revise the mechanics upon notice to the public.

IX. SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

- A. The competition will accept submissions starting August 17, 2019. Deadline of submission is on October 18, 2019.
- B. There is no entry fee for submission.
- C. Each member of the production team, as well as the supervising adult, must submit a photocopy of any document of identification (e.g. valid ID, birth certificate, passport, barangay tax certificate/cedula, etc.)
- D. One (1) copy of the video on a DVD-R or DVD+R must be submitted with the following:
 - 1. Documentary entry in avi or mp4 format.
 - 2. Three to five photos documenting the actual field shooting and editing of the entry.
 - 3. Label with the following details:
 - i. title of the video
 - ii. production name
 - iii. city/province
 - 4. The disc must be placed in a sealed short brown envelope together with the following:
 - i. Official entry form (See attached file)
 - ii. Proof of identification of each member and supervising adult
 - iii. DVD-R or DVD=R containing the entry
- E. Entries may be submitted through:

F. Participants must shoulder the shipping cost of their submission materials.

G. Receipt of entries shall be acknowledged via SMS or electronic mail. Should entrant wish to receive a Certificate of Participation for the production team members, cast, supervising adult, and school, barangay, or organization for whatever legal purpose, a prepaid self-addressed return envelope must be enclosed upon submission of entry.

I. Credits Guidelines:

1. Credits must only be at the **beginning of the video**; still (non-moving); exactly 5 seconds in length; and without background music or countdown

2. All text must be of readable font size and style (e.g., Helvetica, Arial, Calibri); must be of white font color on black background; and listed in an order as

in the following examples.

3. Supervising adults must ensure that music used, if not an original composition of the production team members (i.e. under Creative Commons license), is properly attributed in the credits. Resource guides to fair use and proper attribution may be found online.



Criteria of a Child-Friendly Television (CFTV) Program of the Child-Friendly Content Standards

A television content which may not be specifically produced for viewing by children, but which serves to further the positive development of children and contain no elements that may result in physical, mental, and emotional harm to them. It includes various formats and genre that appeal to children and are made available for all ages.

A child-friendly television program shall meet the following criteria:

- a. Theme The theme or underlying message of the program must be suitable for children. The program should not contain themes the portrayal or depiction of which are suitable only for adults such as adultery, concubinage, pornography, prostitution, incest, rape, fraud, robbery, gun running, arson, kidnapping, sedition, subversion, treason, betrayal of country, abortion, murder, euthanasia, , and other heinous crimes;
- b. Values The important and fundamental beliefs of what is good or bad, right or wrong, desirable or undesirable, depicted in the program must not be contrary to the best interest of the Filipino child. The program must promote positive Filipino cultural values for emotional, moral, spiritual, mental, or physical development of the child. Filipino cultural values include respect for children toward other children, children toward adults, adults toward children, and adults toward adults, regardless of race, nationality, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual preference, physical or mental disabilities. It must also display respect and care for the environment and other living beings;
- c. Dialogue The dialogue, whether in words or gestures, must not promote or encourage children to speak or behave disrespectfully toward other persons or animals;
- **d.** Language The language used, which could be oral or written, must not be vulgar, profane, offensive, sexually suggestive, derogatory or demeaning of a person or animal;
- e. **Nutrition** Depictions or references to food and beverages, which could either be direct or implied, must not promote or condone unhealthy eating;
- f. Sex and Nudity The program must not depict the female breast, genitalia, anus, butt, sexual act, or other images and acts that are sexually suggestive or appropriate only for adult audiences;
- g. Violence There must be no depiction of behavior, attack, confrontation, clash, using or involving the use of physical force with the deliberate intent to damage, hurt, or kill someone or something, with likely effect of inducing or eliciting emotions in children, either of short-term or of great intensity, such as empathy, anger, elevated excitement, conditioned fear, nightmares, tantrums, desensitization, and other trauma-related symptoms.
- h. Substance Use Scenes must not depict images and messages, with the aim, effect or likely effect of promoting, directly or indirectly, a tobacco company, tobacco brand, a tobacco product or tobacco use, heated tobacco products (HTPs), Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS), Electronic Non-Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENNDS), electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), electronic shisha (e-shisha) vapes, and other similar devices, alcohol, stimulants, narcotics, inhalants, depressants, and hallucinogens and other prohibited drugs and chemicals;
- i. Gambling Scenes must not depict images or messages, directly or indirectly, of wagering of money or the betting or staking of something of value with consciousness of risk and hope of gain, on the outcome of a game, a contest, or an uncertain event whose result may be determined by chance or accident or have an unexpected result by reason of the bettor's miscalculation. It includes scenes that suggest wagering as a good or desirable act or behavior.¹
