

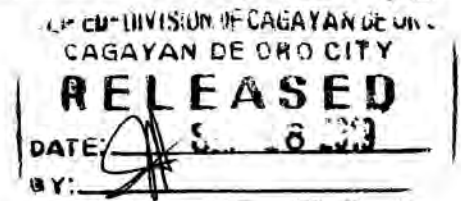




Humanitarian Greetings!

The Philippine Red Cross under the support of the Ridge to Coast, Rain to Tap (R2CR2T Project) will be implementing CHAST Program in the project covered schools namely, Camaman-an Elementary School, Canitoan Elementary School, PN Roa Elementary School and Lumbia Central School. Relative hereto, we will be organizing to conduct Children's Hygiene and Sanitation Transformation (CHAST) Training of WASH Committee. As an overview, CHAST is an approach for promoting good hygiene among children who are vulnerable and those who have poor access on health and sanitation. It uses a variety of exercises and educational games to teach children about the direct links between personal hygiene and good health. CHAST is based on the proven premise that personal hygiene practices are usually acquired during childhood and that is much easier to change the habits of children than those of adults. The CHAST tool will be an effective instrument to increase the capability of the children to address health issues of their own as well as to improve their own cleanliness and hygiene. In addition, the tool aims to encourage the participation of children as an agent for change and for behavioral improvement.

Moreover, proper implementation of the CHAST methodology is needed for the success of the program by means of training the WASH Committee in the covered schools. They will play a role in the implementation of the CHAST program as they will be mobilized and deliver fundamental hygiene lessons to their co-learners. For your overview, below are the components of the WASH Committee:

- One (1) School Administrator
- Two (2) Teachers/Advisers
- Eleven (11) Students
- One (1) representative from the Parent Teacher Association

The activity will be a three (3) day training and is conducted into separate sessions; 1) training for learners and 2) training for adults. Expenses incurred for this activity is charged to the project budget.
