

## 38TH PRINCIPALS TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AND NATIONAL BOARD CONFERENCE

- 1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) will hold the 38th Principals Training and Development Program and National Board Conference (PTDP-NBC) with the theme Duty, Dignity, Integrity and Determination towards Excellent Principal Empowerment from May 3 to 5, 2019 at the ASEAN Convention Center, Claro M.
