

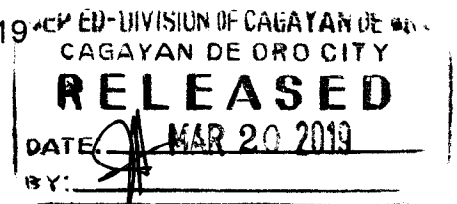



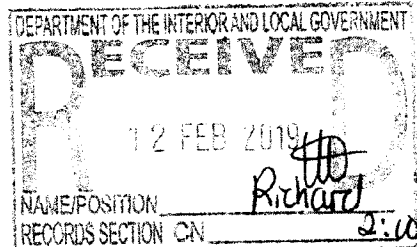
- + Mindanao: March 22-24, 2019 in Cagayan de Oro City;

You may therefore coordinate directly with concerned local government units as regards the participation of Local Chief Executives, Sanggunian Members, and concerned Department Heads in provinces, cities and municipalities. It is understood that the approved Travel Authority issued by the Local Chief Executives of the concerned officials or employees, may form part of the supporting documents for cash advance purposes, subject to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations.
