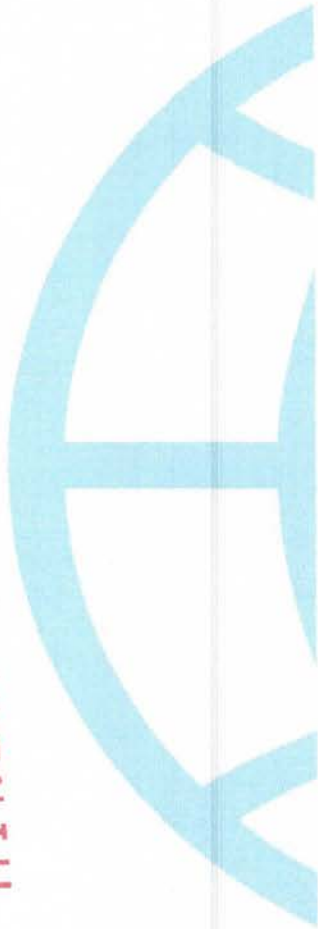

MECHANICS

Rules/Regulations:

1. This short film competition is open to all young filmmakers in Cagayan de Oro City. Only entries by student filmmakers (junior and senior high schools in Cagayan de Oro) will be accepted to the competition and has undergone the SALIDA: UNSDG Film Festival Orientation.
2. All participating schools shall register online through: <http://gg.gg/salidacontest>.
3. Schools may submit a maximum of three (3) entries, but only two (2) entries per school may be considered as finalists.
4. Revised versions of a film, or a film re-submitted under a different title shall be disqualified
5. Entries must have been produced within the period of **April - July 2019 and has been created for the sole purpose of promoting the UNSDG to a wider audience.**

6. The Festival will ensure safety of the films throughout the period in which the cinematographic materials are in its custody. In case of loss or damage to the materials, the Festival's obligation is limited to compensating the production only for the cost of replacing the damaged DVD or USB.
7. All DVD/USB shipments to the Festival must be prepaid and properly labeled.
8. JCI Kagayhaan Gold reserves the right to show the ten (10) digital films for educational purposes including organization initiated outreach programs.
9. Entries selected as finalists cannot be withdrawn from the competition.

Film format:

1. Submitted films must be within 3-5 minutes (including opening credits and closing credits)
2. Filipino or Cebuano/Visayan Languages are preferred with appropriate English subtitles
3. Only ONE UN Sustainable Development Goal must be the main essence of the submitted entry and will revolve around the main theme of "MINDANAO IN FOCUS"
4. Submitted entries may come from any of the different film genres/categories as long as it is within the context of the main theme and must be for General Patronage / R-15 movie classification.
5. All entries must be in digital video format.

Copyright:

1. All entries must be original, never been screened publicly or uploaded on the internet. Furthermore, entries must be specifically made for this competition and has never been submitted for any local, national, or international digital short film exhibition, competition, or festival.
2. Music score or soundtrack must be original, licensed, or in the public domain prior to copyright laws so as to prevent legal complications.

Submission:

1. Participants must submit the following materials on or before **June 28, 2019 (Friday)**, 6:00 p.m. to either of the following:
 - 9000 Events Management Solutions Company, Block 9, Lot 4, NHA Lourdesville Subdivision (near covered court), Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City.

2. The final work must be in **DVD format and USB FLASH Drive (2 copies)**, labeled with the title, production company address and contact numbers, production date, director's name and running time.
3. Submit also the following:
 - The duly completed registration form;
 - Synopsis in English;
 - A brief profile and two (2) recent 2x2 photos of the filmmaker(s).
 - Soft copy of the film posters will be submitted in together with the final cut of the film (USB Flash Drive). Orientation of the poster is PORTRAIT, JPEG FORMAT, and A3 Size. Title of the Film and artistic credits must be visible in the poster.
4. All entries must be submitted in a long brown envelope properly labeled with proponent's name, title and contact details.

Film Screening and Awards:

1. The ten (10) best short features will be announced on **July 8, 2019 (Monday)**.

2. By **July 13, 2019 (Saturday)** each of the chosen ten (10) finalists must submit the following:

- Soft copy of the Synopsis and Logline in English;
- Soft copy of a brief résumé/biodata and profile (bust or medium shot) photo of the filmmaker(s) in jpeg format;
- Eight (8) captioned horizontal production stills in jpeg format to be used for the souvenir program and promotional articles;
- Major credit titles (soft copy);
- Original Poster Design in jpeg format;

3. The ten (10) short feature films will be screened during the **SALIDA Film Festival from August 1-3, 2019** at the select public schools. The films will then be shown on the web through the official Facebook Page and Youtube Channel of JCI Kagayhaan Gold.

4. The best short feature will receive trophies and certificates during the Salida Awards Night on **August 8, 2019** (Venue to be announced).
