## Guidelines and Mechanics

### BASIC INFORMATION

The competition will be held on July 17, 2019 at Limketkai Mall.

### GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Each group shall be composed of a **minimum of 5 dancers up to a maximum of 8 dancers**. Members of the groups may be composed of all males or females, or any combination thereof.
2. No outsiders or professional dancer/s should be part of the group. Automatic disqualification in the contest if the group fails to follow.
3. The music must be at least three (3) minutes but not more than five (5) minutes.
4. Use of props will be allowed as long as it will not cause any delay in the program and any harm to the performance of other groups.
5. Appropriate costume should be observed throughout the competition.
6. All participating groups (**Adult PWDs and SPED High School Students**) shall undergo the Audition process on June 30, 2019.

### CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

Choreography (creativity, artistry, style & originality) - 50%

Execution (Timing & Coordination, Projection & Expression) - 30%

Costume - 10%

Audience Impact - 10%

**Second Prize - P 3, 500.00**

**Third prize - P 2, 500.00**

**Consolation Prize - P 500.00**

**Guidelines and Mechanics**

**1. Objectives:**

- A. To raise awareness and a better understanding on the disability terms, laws and issues.
- B. To develop sportsmanshi.
- C. To bring forth partnership between the PWDs and the Academe.

**2. Categories:**

- Category A - Elementary
- Category B - Junior/Senior High
- Category C - College

**3. Qualifications:**

- For Elementary Level - Contestants must be enrolled in Grades 5 or 6
- For High School Level - Contestants must be from Junior High or Senior High
- For College Level - Contestants could come from 1<sup>st</sup> to higher years.

**4. Registration Fees:**

- Elementary: One Hundred Pesos (P 100.00) each contestants
- Junior/Senior High School: One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 150.00) each contestants
- College: Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) each contestants

**5. Mechanics of QuizzD**

- A. Contestants must form a Team of 3.
- B. One Team per school
- C. Register or inform the CAFEDPA Officials for the desire to join ahead of time.

**6. Rules in General**

- A. There are 3 Rounds ( Easy, Average & Diffiicult )
- B. The questions will be read twice by the Quizz Master
- C. Contestants will be given 10 seconds to answer and is required to raise the board when the Quizz Master says so.
- D. All questions are all in multiple choice
- E. Tie-breaker questions are readyin cases of tie.
- F. The highest scored Team will be proclaimed as winners
- G. All participants are expected to be in their best behaviour to avoid disqualification.
