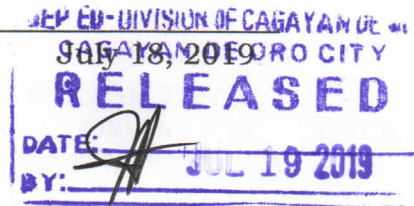

- Title : TROOP LEADERSHIP TRAINING
(BASIC TRAINING, AGE SPECIALIZATION & OUTDOOR TRAINING)
- Proponent : GSP, Misamis Oriental Council
- Date : July 26-28, 2019 & August 3-4, 2019
- Place : Mapawa Nature Park
Malasag, Cugman, Cagayan de Oro City
- Things to bring: - Eating utensils (plate, spoon & fork, drinking glass and mug) (individual)
medical certificate
sleeping garments, individual personal needs, mosquito repellent, complete, Jogging pants, rubber shoes, sit-upon, flashlight, writing materials, malong/shawl, sleeping materials (bedroll, mats etc) **Tent**
- Registration : P 1,500/ participant- to cover meals and snacks, venue training, materials/outdoor materials, and other operational expenses. This may charge to MOOE/GS Funds/Local School Board, subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures.

- Duration : 2 weekends (5 days)
- Participants : **Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Teachers**

 2. Shall be able to take and manage a girl scout troop
