

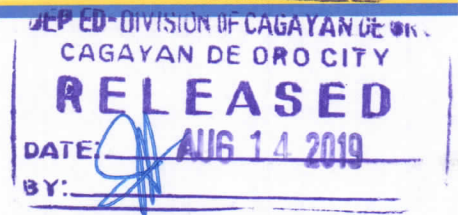

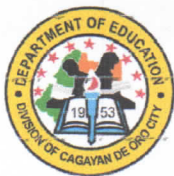

6. **All School Paper Advisers in the Public/ Private Schools shall attend a Consultative Meeting on August 19, 2019, (Monday), 8:00 am** at GFS Building of Fr. William Masterson SJ ES, Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City.

7. A registration Fee of one Hundred Pesos (100.00) cash per participant including the coach to cover the cost of judges/speakers honoraria and other operating expenses will be collected upon Pre-registration/Online Registration on August 16 to September 6, 2019, 8:00 am-5:00 pm at Gazebo of Fr. William Masterson ES. Late registrants and walk-in registrants will be entertained during the Opening Program. Registration, travelling, meals and other related expenses shall be charged to MOOE, local/ school paper funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.

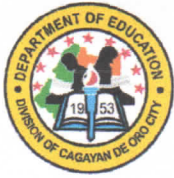
8. A membership fee of Sixty pesos (60.00) cash for school paper adviser and Thirty pesos (30.00) cash for the campus journalist shall be collected by the Cagayan de Oro City School Paper Advisers and Editors Guild Association Inc. upon registration to secure the association ID.

9. School Paper Advisers from each participating school must submit six (6) copies of the first issue of their school publication for SY 2019-2020 with a twelve to sixteen-page school paper (six copies for English and/ or six copies for Filipino) (9 x 12 but can be printed in A4 size book paper for elementary, for junior and senior high schools is 12 x 18 which can be printed to A3 size of bond paper). This Office further notifies the field that the conference adheres to the "NO PAPER, NO CONTEST Policy and No Association Issued ID, No Entry. Likewise, School Paper Advisers are required to submit the names of contestants for the selection of this year's Search for Outstanding Campus Journalist and School Paper Adviser and on August 21, 2019, 8:00 am-5:00 pm at the GFS Building of Fr. William Masterson ES. Attention: All CDOCSPAEG Officers while the submission of the school paper will be on September 2, 2019. Submit your school paper to Jennifer Cañete, teacher of West City Central School.

10. The top seven winners in **ALL** (Individual and Group) events per contest category per medium shall be recognized during the closing program and awarding ceremony which shall be on the second day, September 12, 2019. Only the top three winners shall represent this Division to the Regional Schools Press Conference. However, for the **group contests** (Radio Broadcasting, TV Broadcasting and Collaborative Desktop Publishing), the first placers will **be automatically be the regional qualifiers**.

11. The names and number of participants shall be reflected on the Confirmation Sheets <http://deped.in/2019DSPCRegistration> which will be submitted on or before August 16, to September 6-, 2019 at the School Gazebo of Fr. William Masterson ES. Attention: All CDOCSPAEG Officers, 09163277319.

12. School can send two or three participants for each category of the individual writing events provided that the school has the capacity to pay for the registration fee. This is to maximize the potential writers especially to the big schools.

13. Schools with Senior High School can separately join with Junior High Schools in the 2018 Division Schools Press Conference.

14. Contestants for the Copyreading and Headline Writing and Editorial Cartooning must bring pencil (Mongol No. 2).

15. Column Writing as a new contest will be conducted both in Filipino and in English for elementary and secondary levels while the Online Publishing will be conducted both in Filipino and in English for secondary level only.

16. In Photojournalism, digital cameras (point and shoot) up to 20 megapixels only will be used. DSLR and other high end cameras will not be permitted to join the photoshoot.

17. Contestants for Collaborative Publishing and Radio Broadcasting must bring their own laptops, printers and extension wire/cord. Collaborative Publishing contestants will also be the same contestants for Collaborative Online Publishing.

18. Radio Broadcasting in English and Filipino both in the elementary and secondary level is a separate event from the writing competitions. It is strongly advised that the seven (7) members of this competition shall be separate from the school's official contestants in the individual writing events. For schools joining this particular event, a different set of contestants both in English and Filipino is required.

19. There will be a competition on TV Script Writing and Broadcasting (English) in the elementary and secondary level. Schools who are interested to participate in this event shall field a team of seven (7) members. The team shall decide who shall act as scriptwriters, news writers and infomercial or developmental communication writers, anchors, reporters, producer/director who could also act as floor director, technical or music director, and video director or editor. The team must bring their own materials and equipment such as the following:

- Laptop with at least IOGB free space and a video editing program;
- Two (2) empty flash drives;
- Digital camera or phone camera, which is compatible with the laptop for the downloading of media;
- Compatible printer with ink; and

20. To determine the overall score, the total Individual Score of all individual events and the total Group Score of Group events (Radio Broadcasting, TV Broadcasting, Collaborative Desktop Publishing and School Paper Category) shall be summed up in a point system.

22. All participants of the DSPC 2019 are advised to bring their food (meals and snacks) and other paraphernalia for the different contest events. Transportation expenses, foods (meals and snacks) and other materials for the contest shall be charged to the school downloaded funds/School MOOE, School Publication Fund, PTA Funds, Canteen Funds subject to the usual accounting, auditing, rules and regulations.

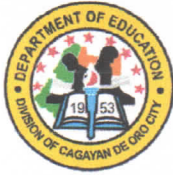

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF WINNERS IN THE DIFFERENT INDIVIDUAL  
WRITING CONTESTS

The competition in the Individual Writing Contest is designed to showcase the competencies of campus journalists, demonstrate their holistic journalistic skills and proficiency through media exposure, immersion and press conferences, and promote free responsible journalism.

The following will be strictly implemented and complied with:

A. General:

1. To facilitate proper identification, the participants are required to wear their school uniform with their valid school ID especially during the contest.
2. Should there be questions and assistance needed, the participants can only raise their concerns to the assigned proctor. The proctor shall refer them to the Division TWG for appropriate response to their queries or concerns.
3. The top seven winners per medium shall be recognized and the points they will garner will be included in the computation of the overall scores.
4. Any violation of the stipulated guidelines will be grounds for disqualification of the participant.
5. The decision of the members of the Board of Judges in all aspects of the contest shall be deemed final and irrevocable.

B. Specific:

1. Sports Writing:

- a. The DTWG shall orient and provide final instructions to the campus journalists before the contest proper.
- b. A pre-game conference shall be conducted for the introduction of the players, coaches, and tournament officials. Consequently, a post conference shall be held for further interview and data gathering.
- c. Contestants shall be made to watch an actual game where they can gather appropriate data and/or interview officials and athletes before and after the game.

2. Copy Reading & Headline Writing:

- a. The contestants shall use the standard copyreading symbols and follow directions given in the contest piece.
- b. The contestants will also provide two headlines for the article that they have edited and include the appropriate printer's directions.

- a. Only pencils with erasers provided by the organizers shall be used.
  - b. The cartoon must reflect the elements of editorial cartooning.
  - c. The cartoon should be, at all times, compliant with the professional and ethical standards of media.
4. Photojournalism
- a. Preparation:
    - 1) Participants should be at the contest venue thirty (30) minutes before the orientation.
    - 2) The photojournalists are allowed to use any Digital Camera (print and shoot only with maximum of 16 mega pixels. Contestants who shall bring any DSLR and other high-end cameras will not be permitted to join the photo shoot.
    - 3) The student contestant should bring his own camera cable for uploading of pictures.
    - 4) Cellular phones, extra digital cameras, extra storage card or any additional materials/equipment are not allowed in the contest area.
  - b. Memory Card Loading:

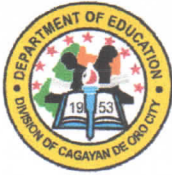
The contestants will load the storage card in front of the examiners/proctors.
  - c. Photo Shoot
    1. After announcing the contest theme/topic, the first shot (control shot) by all contestants should be focused on one subject as determined by the examiner/proctor
    2. Every contestant is given 1 (one) hour to take pictures, which does not include the loading and unloading of the storage card in front of the examiners/proctors.
    3. During the actual photo shooting, advisers/trainers/parents of the contestants are not allowed in the venue.
    4. The contestants are allowed to take ten (10) photos but only four (4) shots (including the control shot) will be submitted as official entries.
    5. Three (3) best photos and the control shot will be uploaded by the contestant to the laptop/desktop of the assigned DTWG for judging.
    6. Caption per picture should be encoded by the contestant upon uploading of the photos to the laptop/desktop.

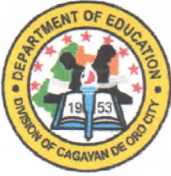

**Search for the Most Outstanding School Paper Advisers  
Guidelines**

1. The Division School Paper Advisers Association and Editor's Guild, Inc (SPAAEG) in cooperation with the Department of Education, Division of Cagayan de Oro shall select one outstanding school paper advisers for elementary and secondary.
2. The panel of judges shall be composed of the following:
  - 2.1. The Division Journalism Coordinator as Chairman; The President of the Association as Co-Chairman and the Incumbent Outstanding School Paper Adviser as member. In case, one of them waives to judge, the President of the Association can nominate any from officers of the association.
  - 2.2. The announcement of winners will be announced on August 5, 2019.

**CRITERIA**

- 1. LENGTH OF SERVICE AND PERFORMANCE RATING 10 PTS**
  - 1.1. Must have been a school paper adviser for at least five (5) consecutive years immediately prior to the search. 5 pts.
  - 1.2. Must have an average performance rating of not lower than satisfactory rating for the past three (3) school years. 5 pts.

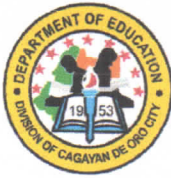

#### HOW TO COMPUTE FOR THE OVERALL SCORES

1. The scores of each of the seven Top Performing Schools per level (elementary and secondary) shall be added to identify the Top Three Performing Schools of the DSPC. The sum of the scores of each school is ranked from highest to lowest.
2. The total score of the Top Seven School in the secondary and elementary level is the sum of all the scores garnered in both group and individual contests. The sum of the scores is ranked from highest to lowest.
3. The total score of the Individual Contest is the sum of the total score of all individual events. The sum of the scores of each school is ranked from highest to lowest.
4. The total score of the Group Contest is the sum of all the scores garnered by each school from Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting, Collaborative Desktop Publishing and School Paper Competitions. The sum of the scores of each school is ranked from highest to lowest.
5. Each contest category follows the same manner of computation, with the figures called from the average scores given by all the judges of each contest/category
