

REGIONAL EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO (EsP) CELEBRATION

To : **Schools Division Superintendents**
This Region

1. In regard to Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 7, 1994 declaring the month of November of every year as “Filipino Values Month,” the Department of Education – Region X, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the **Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) Celebration** at El Salvador City Central School, Division of El Salvador City, on November 7, 2019 (for the Elementary Level) and November 8, 2019 (for the Secondary Level).

2. The theme of the activity is “Madaling Maging Tao, Mahirap Magpakatao.”

3. The celebration is aimed at enabling the participants to achieve the following:

- a. Develop all round and well-balanced personality;
- b. Inculcate good manners and responsible and cooperative citizenship;
- c. Enable the learners to make decisions on the basis of sound moral principles;
- d. Provide better understanding on the importance of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) in transforming a humane society;
- e. Demonstrate commitment to support the advocacy of EsP through healthy and friendly competitions; and
- f. Enhance the talents and skills of student-participants and teacher-coaches in the different events by promoting the real Filipino values.

4. The different events for both elementary and secondary levels are **likha-awit, oratorical/extemporaneous speech, poster making, and documentary video presentation**. No contestant shall participate in two events. Guidelines, criteria of the contests, and names of responsible facilitators are attached for reference.





5. It is encouraged that each division shall conduct its school, district, and divisional level celebrations. The divisional first-place winners and their coaches will represent in the Regional Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) Celebration.
6. The participants of this activity are the divisional education program supervisors in charge of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, winning students and pupils in the different levels with their teacher-coaches, school heads of the winning schools, and identified district and school coordinators in charge of EsP.
7. Travel, board, lodging, and other related expenses of the participants shall be charged against school/local/MOOE/local school board funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is advised that PTA and non-government funds and other funding sources be tapped for financial assistance. Medals, certificates, cash prizes, honoraria/token of the judges/facilitators, tarpaulin and other incidental expenses shall be charged against Regional Office (RO) MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. The participating pupils/students shall be given an alternative course work in lieu of the class activities they might miss during the conduct of the celebration and be given reasonable time to comply with and submit any course requirements in the different subject areas.
9. The divisional EsP coordinators shall take with them documents duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) certifying that their contestants are officially enrolled for SY 2019-2020.
10. The list of divisional officials, coaches, and contestants must be emailed at rositayburan@yahoo.com not later than October 18, 2019.

 GUIDELINES, MECHANICS, AND CRITERIA**

Theme: **“Madaling Maging Tao, Mahirap Magpakatao”**

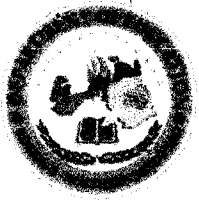
A. Likha-Awit - (OPM Songwriting Competition)

1. The divisional winner for best composer/composition will be the official entry to the competition. One song is allowed per division.
2. A student participant per division shall be accompanied by one coach.
3. The song must be written in Filipino.
4. The songwriter must write inspirational song that is an adaptation of any popular music.
5. Song performance must not exceed three (3) minutes.
6. The performer may use guitar, minus one or any form of keyboard as accompaniment.
7. Three (3) copies of the encoded song lyrics must be provided.
8. The contestants shall wear their IDs for checking and verification.
9. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placers will receive cash and personalized medals with certificates while the non-winners and the teacher coaches will receive certificates.
10. The decision of judges is irrevocable and final.
11. The following are the criteria for judging:

Content/Lyrics (Relevance to the Theme)	30%
Voice Quality	30%
Interpretation/Stage Presence	25%
Dynamics/Tone/Rhythm	15%
Total	100%

B. Oratorical Speech (For Elementary Level Only)

1. There will be one entry per division.
2. The substance should be relevant to the theme.
3. The delivery should not exceed to three (3) minutes.
4. The following are the criteria for judging:

Content/Substance/Originality	50%
Delivery (3mins)	40%
Stage Presence/Performance	10%
Total	100%

5. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. They will receive medals with certificates.

6. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

C. Extemporaneous Speech (For Secondary level Only- Grade 7-10)

1. The delivery is within five (5) minutes.
2. The content message must be in Filipino.
3. There will be only one contest piece. While waiting for their turn, the contestants must be placed in a secluded room. The coaches are not allowed to enter the room.
4. The following are the criteria for judging:

Delivery

(Diction/Pronunciation/Grammar/Originality) 40%

Stage presence

(Appropriate Gesture and Personal Appearance) 20%

Content Message/Relevance to the theme 40%

Total 100%

D. Poster Making

1. The divisional 1st place winner with one (1) coach will be the official entry to the regional level.

2. Contestants should bring their own materials (½ illustration board and water color or pastel). They may use any color.

3. Poster making must be done in one (1) setting/scene.

4. The time limit is two (2) hours.

5. The criteria of the contest are the following:

Content (Relevance to the Theme)	30%
Originality	40%
Design	30%
Total	100%

6. There will be five (5) winners in this contest. Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placers will receive personalized medals with certificates while the non-winners and the teacher-coaches will receive certificates.

7. Decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

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E. Documentary Video Presentation

Mechanics:

1. Contestants should be a team composed of three (3) members either from Grades 4, 5, and 6 (for the elementary level) and Grades 8, 9, and 10 (for the Secondary level).
2. The contestant will choose a family in their local community, which they consider a model family and will serve as the subject of their presentation.
3. Prior to the contest, the team will collect pictures, and video footages of the chosen family.
4. During the contest proper, the teams should take with them their own laptops (with the installed necessary applications, such as movie maker, adobe, power director and sony vegas, and other video application needed for the documentary creation), extension wires, video footages of the subject family, pictures, and background music. One laptop will be used in every team.
5. The documentary video, in an MPEG-4 file format, must be produced only at the designated contest venue.
6. The contestants will be given a two (2) hours to create their output.
7. The documentary video presentation should run only between five (5) to seven (7) minutes. If the presentation will be less or more than the allotted time, a deduction of one (1) point shall be imposed.
8. The criteria for judging is as follows:

Originality	25
Relevance to the Theme	20
Impact	20
Creativity and technicality (sounds and visual effects and the flow of the presentation)	25
Time	10
Total	100

9. The footage of the venue during the actual contest will be incorporated in the final output.
10. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
