

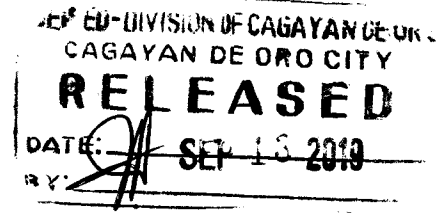

MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSES ON WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE (WASH) IN SCHOOLS (WinS) PILOT RUN

1. As per unnumbered Deped Memorandum from ATTY. NEPOMUCENO A. MALALUAN, Undersecretary and Chief of Staff re: Conduct of Massive Open Online Courses on Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (Wash) in Schools (WinS) Pilot Run, you are hereby directed to participate in the online courses which will commence on September 16, 2019 to November 15, 2019.
2. The online school level training aims the following:
 - a. Strengthen the competencies needed to set-up a suitable school environment;
 - b. Supports learning by promoting dignity and gender equality in school(s);
 - c. Improves learner's participation in schools;
 - d. Helps learners achieve both learning and health outcomes.
3. The 40 Hour courses, lodged at the Knowledge Education and Exchange Platform(KEEP) maintained by the Chinese University of Hongkong (CUHK). Course completers will earn an international training certificate. The courses are being offered for Free, and have applied for CPD Units.

SUBJECT: *Massive Open Online Courses on Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Pilot Run*

DATE: 23 August 2019

1. The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services, in collaboration with German Society for International Cooperation (GIZ) Regional Fit for School, SEAMEO Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH), and the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), will be conducting the pilot run of the massive open online courses (MOOCs) on Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS). Two courses will be offered – one for school-level participants, and another for division officials.
2. Leading WinS, the school-level course, aims to strengthen the competencies needed to set-up a suitable school environment that: (i) supports learning by promoting dignity and gender equality in school; (ii) improves learner's participation in schools; and (iii) helps learners achieve both learning and health outcomes.

Specifically, at the end of the course participants will be able to:

- a. develop learning outputs within an online learning platform
 - b. create an advocacy speech to motivate and engage the community to collaborate on improving the school environment to meet the DepEd's WinS Standards
 - c. prepare an analysis of the school environment vis-à-vis the DepEd's WinS Standards
 - d. formulate an action plan to improve and/or address the school's WinS issues
 - e. develop a sustainability plan that promotes transparency of actions, sharing of responsibilities with the wider school community, and accountability for results
3. The division-level MOOC aims (i) to strengthen the motivation of SDO WinS Technical Working Group (TWG) to manage better the program; and (ii) to define their key roles, as well as other SDO personnel in managing the WinS program in the division and in supporting schools.

Specifically, at the end of the course participants will be able to:



- a. develop an action plan to strengthen the management enablers of the SDO that will facilitate the provision of technical assistance to schools
 - b. use relevant WinS resource material/s in capacitating schools with simple techniques that will improve WinS practices
 - c. create a plan of technical assistance to schools to enable them to effectively implement WinS
4. The 40-hour courses, lodged at the Knowledge Education and Exchange Platform (KEEP) maintained by the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK), will run from **September 16 to November 15** for the **school-level MOOC**, while the **division-level MOOC** will run from **October 14 to December 31** this year. Course completers will earn an international training certificate. The courses are being offered for free, and have been applied for CPD credits.
 5. These self-paced courses allow more flexibility in completing the course activities as discussions are asynchronous. Learners can access the MOOC at any time and take it at their own pace. Thus, they have more control over the schedule of their participation. Suggested schedules will be provided to guide them in their pace.
 6. The target participants for the pilot run of both courses are teachers and school leaders from the pre-identified seventeen (17) schools division offices (SDOs). Each division is given a specified number of schools that can participate on a mandatory or voluntary basis. SDOs are requested to ensure that slots for them will be filled up.

Personnel under **mandatory participation** will be required to enroll and finish the course. Performance of these enrollees will be closely monitored and reported to their concerned immediate supervisors.

Regions and SDOs participating on a **voluntary basis** will post an open invitation to schools interested in and committed to complete the course.

All participants need to **self-enroll** at www.keep.edu.hk. Refer to *Enclosure B* for the detailed instructions.

7. For the school-level MOOC, each school is expected to send two participants: one (1) School Head and one (1) teacher assigned as WinS focal person or school-level WinS coordinator.

For the division-level MOOC, participants will come from the same 17 divisions where the school level MOOC participants were selected. Each participating division is given four (4) slots for the MOOC. The participants should be any of the following:

- a. member of the Division WinS TWG (priority criteria)
 - b. division supervisor and/or health personnel tasked to manage the WinS program in the SDO and plays an important role in providing technical assistance to schools on WinS implementation

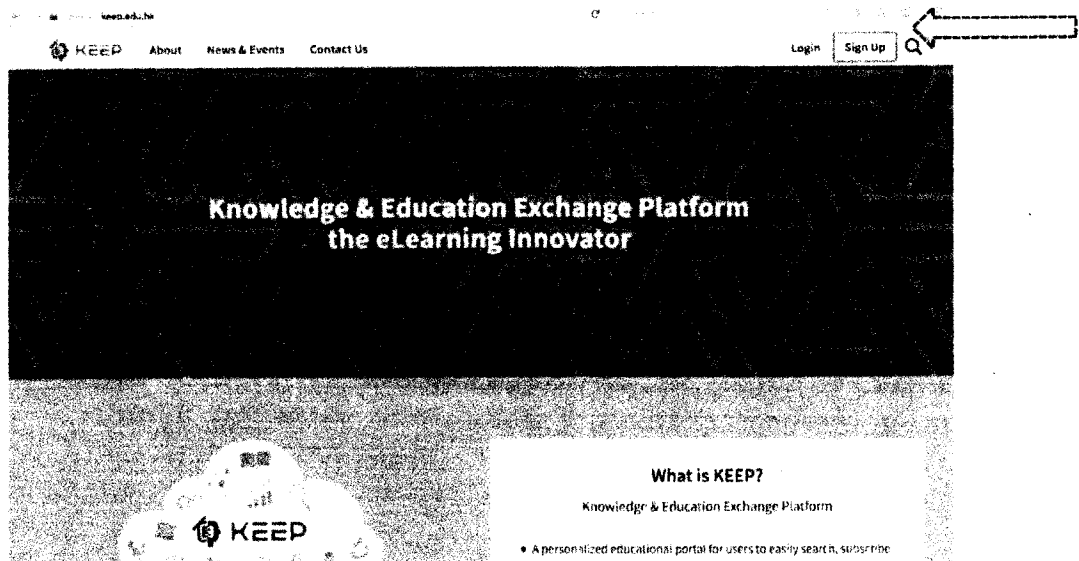
LEADING WINS IN SCHOOLS

Welcome to LEADING WINS, a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on WASH in Schools. Follow the step by step guide below to enroll.

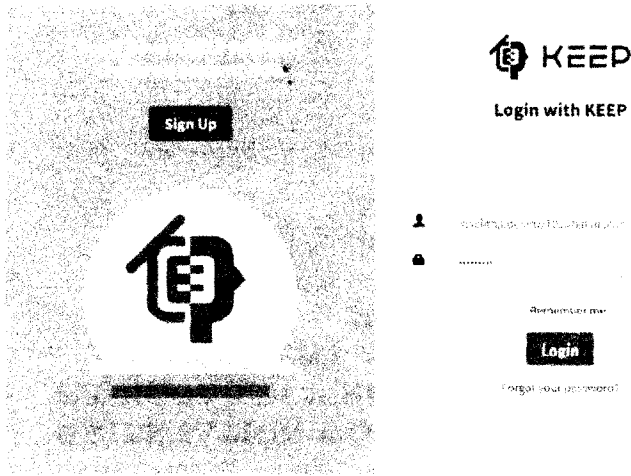
The course is running on a platform, KEEP (Knowledge and Education Exchange).

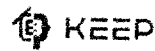
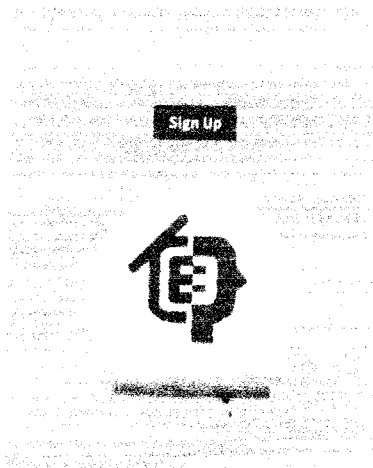

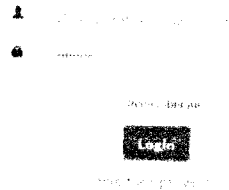
