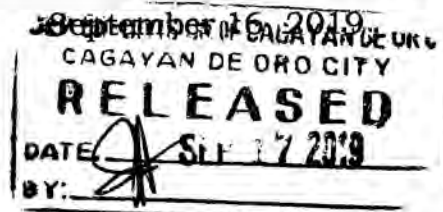

The Search for the Most Child-Friendly Police Station

The Search for the Most Child-Friendly Police Station is a social audit done annually by different private and public sectors of Cagayan de Oro City. There is a common impression among children that law enforcement officers are frightening. Often, they are used to scare a child into submission for fear that these officers will take them away. One of the project's aims is to change this image of law enforcement - from stately authoritative figures to actual people who protects the welfare and dignity of our children. Apart from this, the social audit targets several aspects in the course of a police station's operations regarding the welfare of children such include a child-friendly space, a Women and Children's Desk Officer, the confidentiality and safekeeping of files and cases involving minors, the monitoring and processing of cases involving minors, precautionary measures when dealing with minors whether victimized or accused, and more.

The Search for the Most Child-Friendly Police Station also takes into consideration the coordination between the police station and the barangay through the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC). The frequency of their monitoring and the actual hands-on processing of minor cases are a few factors that the barangay evaluation team checks. In order to utilize the budget allocated per police station for child-related initiatives, the search also looks into the projects and programs that each station conducts for the children and youth in their area of jurisdiction. The projects' sustainability and resourcefulness are scrutinized to ensure that these activities will yield fruitful and long-term results.

The Oro Youth Development Council (OYDC), being the highest policy recommending body for youth concerns engages not only on policy development but also service improvement. The OYDC understands that our public institutions are strengthened when ordinary citizens demand accountability and transparency. There are many ways to accomplish this. One way is a social accountability audit for services, and for this particular case, a social audit on every police station's children's protection desk. What is unique about this program is it is wholly developed and led by private youth organizations with the support of civil society and the local government unit.

This program is aligned with the OYDC's thrust to make Cagayan de Oro a child-rights literate city where both duty-bearers and citizens are partners in improving the city's position as a child-friendly community.

ORO YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

January 22, 2018 – the City Ordinance 13369-2018 otherwise known as the Oro Youth Code, a landmark legislation which aims to institutionalize youth participation in local governance, was unanimously approved by the 18th Cagayan de Oro City Council. The passage of this ordinance creates the Oro Youth Development Office (OYDO), institutionalized the Oro Youth Development Council (OYDC), defines youth sectors, and mandates youth representation in various city committees.

A little after the approval of the Oro Youth Code, the OYDO launched the 1st Oro Youth Organization Registration Program with the objective of creating a network of youth leaders in Cagayan de Oro. A total of fifty-six (56) youth organizations made it in the first round of registration.

The Oro Youth Development Council is composed of different sectors, namely: In School, Out of School, Faith-based, Cultural-identity, Community-based, and Special Advocacy-based. It is chaired by the SK Federated Chairperson and a Sectoral Co-chairperson elected by the registered youth organizations. It leads the finalization of Local Youth Development Plan, implement and monitor projects stipulated in the LYDP and assist its member organizations in planning and executing their respective projects.
