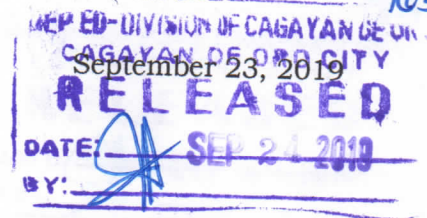

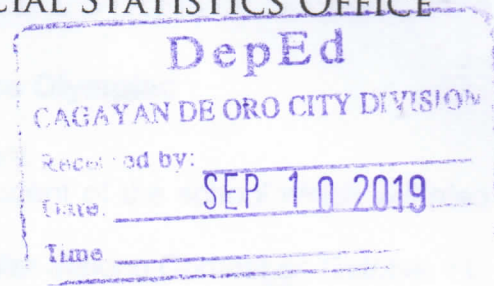

Guidelines for the Statistics Olympiad

1. Each participating school will send one participant.
2. Participants should be a bonafide Grade 11 student of the school which will also have one official coach.
3. The contest is done simultaneously with the Poster Making Contest on October 11, 2019 at 1pm at the Activity Center of Limketkai Mall.
4. The contestants and coaches should submit the following documents as their registration on or before **October 4, 2019 at the PSA – Misamis Oriental Office in Gusa**
 - Resume / Curriculum Vitae with 1x1 photo
 - Official endorsement of the School Head/Principal where the contestant is enrolled

5. Contestants may use scientific calculators. The contestants and coaches should register the calculator that will be used during the Olympiad. The registered calculators will be kept and returned to the contestants when they are already seated at their assigned seats.
6. The Quiz shall have three sequential rounds – Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3. Should the need arises, tie – breaker questions will be administered. Each round will have 10 questions (each of which will have 4 choices).
 - A trial question will be given before the start of Round 1.
 - The quizmaster will read the question twice, the five choices and the time limit for the question.
 - The official timekeeper will signal the end of the time allotted for answering a specific question for which the quizmaster will announce, “time is up!”. Each team should then raise their answer.
 - The quizmasters will then announce the correct answer and will proceed to read the answer of each contestant.
 - Examiners will tally the scores.
 - Rounds 1 and 2 correct answers will have one point each while round 3 will have 2 points each.
 - If in case of ties, a winner will be determined on the scores in Round 1. And if still there occurs a tie, scores in Round 2 will be assessed on who has the higher score.
 - Contestants will be given answer sheets on which they will write their answer.

THEME: “Data Innovation: Key to a Better Nation”

1. Introduction

Poster Making Contest is an adopted concept of competition which enhances student’s talents, creativity, imagination, independence, and idealism, and develops thereto his/her knowledge and perception about the affairs of his/her society which can be expressed through his/her work of art. However, the participant must have to conform to the criteria set forth by the designated committee. The entry of each participant shall be submitted to the Philippine Statistics Authority .The judging and evaluation shall be based primarily on the criteria set forth by the designated committee.

2. Objectives

This contest aims to:

- 2.1. enable participants to be more aware on the important uses of statistics in all development-planning activities.
- 2.2. enhance students knowledge on sociological and economic developmental perspective
- 2.3. allow students to get involved in the affairs and development of their community and society in general.
- 2.4. enhance the students’ artistic skills.
- 2.5. disseminate information through artistic rendition of ideas.

3. Mechanics

3.1 Each school is allowed only to send One (1) Grade 11 contestant. The school contestant shall register with the PSA – Misamis Oriental on or before October 4, 2019 Bring the following upon registration:

- Resume / Curriculum Vitae with 1x1 photo
- Official endorsement of the School Head/Principal where the contestant is enrolled

- 3.3 The contest is done simultaneously with the Statistics Olympiad on October 11, 2019 at 1pm at the Activity Center of Limketkai Mall.
- 3.4 Each contestant will be given a white cartolina. The contestant is given the freedom to use any coloring materials.
- 3.5 The contestant has to submit an entry relative to the theme and on the criteria given.
- 3.6 Each contestant is given 2 hours to finish their entry.
- 3.7 The judging and evaluation shall be based primarily on the criteria set forth by the designated committee.
- 3.8 In case of a tie in the ranking of entries, the Chairman of the Board of Judges is authorized to break a tie.
- 3.9 The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and irrevocable.

4. For the purpose of the contest, the following criteria with corresponding weights shall be considered:

4.1. Relevance to the Theme	40 %
4.2. Artistic rendition (including creativity blending and harmony of colors, etc.)	40 %
4.3. Originality	10%
4.4. Over-all Impact	10%
TOTAL	100%
