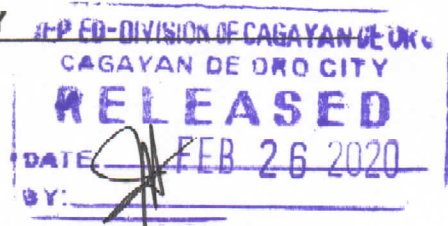



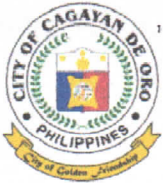
General Guidelines

ACAPPELLA SINGING CONTEST

- ❖ The competition shall be participated by the different Public (Secondary) Junior High Schools in the city. Each shall have one (1) entry composed of four (4) and maximum of five (5) POPDEV CLUB members. Thus, each school will be represented by one (1) singing group only.
- ❖ The piece to be sung is entitled, *"Go the Distance"* popularized by Michael Bolton.
- ❖ Each group are allowed to make an *AREGLO* or *Arrangement* of the song and perform it through an *Acapella*.
- ❖ Each group is allowed and encourage to choose a song for their "Warm-up Piece".
- ❖ Each performing group will have an allotted time of 8-10minutes for the performance. Time immediately starts the moment they enter the stage.
- ❖ In case the group exceeds the allotted time limit, the board of judges will have the right to deduct a corresponding point/s from the group.
- ❖ No musical instruments allowed during the competition.
- ❖ Winners will be identified through the following criteria:

DANCE DRAMA COMPETITION

1. The competition shall be participated by the different Public (Secondary) Junior High Schools in the city. Each shall have one (1) entry composed of ten (10) and maximum of fifteen (15) members. Thus, each District will be represented by one entry only.
2. Each group will be given a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of ten (10) minutes to perform including entrance and exit.
3. In case the presentation exceeds in the allotted time limit, there will be an automatic deduction of points to the final score. 1 minute is equivalent to 1 point deduction.
4. Entries are highly encourage to perform a mixed of modern and cultural genre for their performance which must be in relation to the theme *"Pagkaplag: Hudyaka sa Kabata-an, Kaugmaon Dili Kalimtan, ASRH atong Timbayayongan."*
5. Props such as explosives, weaponries, sharp objects, pyro-techniques, slippery materials etc. that may cause harm to the performers, judges and audience is strictly prohibited.
6. Winners will be identified through the following criteria:

Moral lesson and Message	15%
Mastery/Synchronization	20%
Performance and Execution	20%
Relevance to the Theme	20%
Props and Costume	15%
<u>Audience Impact</u>	10%
Total	100%



DANCE CHANT

1. The competition shall be participated by the different Public (Secondary) Junior High Schools in the city. Each shall have one (1) entry composed of Twenty (20) and maximum of Thirty (30) members. Thus, each school will be represented by one entry only.
2. The performance must at least 5 minutes and will not exceed to 10 minutes including entrance and exit.
3. The Chant or Yells must be related to the theme *"PAGKAPLAG: Hudyaka sa Kabata-an, Kaugmaon Dili Kalimtan, ASRH atong Timbayayongan."*
4. Only snare drum shall be used as an accompaniment during the presentation. For the props to be used, it should be handy and must not exceed to human size; no standy platform and the like be allowed.
5. Stunts and lifting is strictly prohibited.
6. Winners will be identified through the following criteria:

POSTER- MAKING CONTEST

1. The competition shall be participated by the different Public (Secondary) Junior High Schools in the city. Each entries shall have two (2) participants.
2. The poster must illustrate and interpret the current situation of the CDO youth and their significant contribution in terms of resolving issues on Teenage Pregnancy, HIV AIDS and drug Addiction.
3. Each participants shall provide their own materials. This includes; ¼ illustration board (white background & vertical format) and a Mongol pencil. For coloring materials, oil pastel/craypas, markers, ink, mixed media, oil, acrylic and watercolor.
4. Each participants shall be given two (2) hours to finish the output. Entries will be exhibited during the POPDEV Festival of Talents and will be automatically become official property of the Oro Youth Center.
5. The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:
Creativity and Presentation (40%),
Originality (30%) and
Relevance to the Theme (30%).

TEASER VIDEO MAKING CONTEST

1. The competition shall be participated by the different Public (Secondary) Junior High Schools in the city. Each entries shall be composed of four (4) members.



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2. The video must be less than one (1) minute and must not exceed in Three (3) minutes. The video shall cover the Festival of Talent Activities and its purpose.
 3. All entries must be original, unpublished online or in any other media platform, and must be done during the POPDev Festival of talents. Songs and musical scoring should have no copyright infringement.
 4. Contestants must bring their own equipment.
 5. Entries will be shown during the POPDEV Festival of Talents and will be automatically become official property of the Oro Youth Center.
 6. Entries must be submitted to on or before 12:00nn.
 7. The video will be judged according to the following criteria:
 - a. Creativity and presentation (40%),
 - b. Originality (30%) and
 - c. Relevance to the theme and overall appeal (30%).
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SPEAKING POETRY

1. The competition shall be participated by the different Public (Secondary) Junior High Schools in the city. Each entries shall have two (2) participants.
2. The literary piece to be delivered by the participants shall focus on CDO youth and their significant contribution in terms of resolving issues on Teenage Pregnancy, HIV AIDS and Drug Addiction.
3. Each contestant shall be given minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) minutes for the delivery of the piece.
4. The literary piece shall either be delivered in Filipino or Bisaya.
5. The participant shall wear a school uniform.
6. The winners shall be identified based on the following criteria;

Organization and Content	50%
Delivery	25%
<u>Style and Presentation</u>	25%
Total	100%

BOOTH EXHIBIT

1. The booth exhibit shall be participated by the different District Secondary schools in the city. Each district shall have one (1) booth entry only.
 2. Each entry shall be given a space with a total dimension of 3 x 4 m. Booths will be placed at the City Hall quadrangle.
 3. For the booth exhibit, it should have a display of best practices, accomplishments, programs and activities of the school related to adolescent sexuality and reproductive health campaign.
 4. Each booth are anticipated to have a creative decorations and displays to capture the attention of the audience. Seal and or logos of the participating school should be displayed in front of the booth for recognition.
 5. During the judging, there are only three (3) students and one (1) teacher who are allowed to stay in their respective booth to entertain and explain their exhibit and display to the judges. Presenters must wear their school uniform.
 6. The use of TV, laptop, soundbox, karaoke and or speaker is allowed, provided that it shall not distract the other booth and the volume is low.
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
