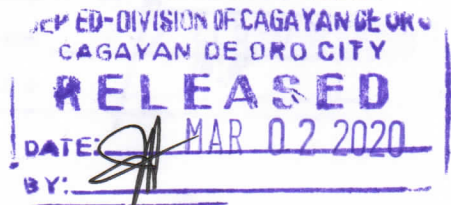

CHAST is an approach that Philippine Red Cross uses in promoting good hygiene among children; it uses a child to child approach wherein the child will serve as an agent of change in their community. This approach also utilizes a variety of exercises and educational games to teach children about the link between personal hygiene and good health. CHAST is based on the proven premise that personal hygiene practices are usually acquired during childhood and that is much easier to change the habits of children than those of adults.


