

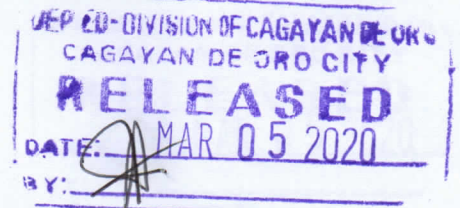

Greetings!

The **Kaabag sa Kalambuan pinaagi sa Kabtangan sa Katilingban (KKKK)**, a project of Xavier Science Foundation and working with **ChildFund Philippines**, started its program on Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health (ASRH) in Dansolihon, Mambuaya and Bayanga during the last quarter of 2019. Tumpagon was later added to the list especially in the capacity building of the youth volunteers. The programs aims to increase the knowledge and social emotional life skills among young adolescence. In partnership with the DepED Cagayan de Oro Division and Oro Youth Development Center, KKKK supported the establishments of Teen Centers in Dansolihon NHS, Mambuaya NHS, Bayanga NHS, Midkiwan NHS (Bayanga Annex) and Tumpagon NHS. The Teen Centers serve as a venue and platform for the students to discuss issues and coping strategies on adolescent sexual behaviours, emotions, mental health and interpersonal relations.

The program also trained a group of peer educators/advocates or peer helpers along with their guidance designates on the different modules of ASRH. Most of them have successfully implemented roll out activities in their respective schools. As we near the closing of this school year, we find it important to gather all those were trained for the **Peer Educators' Kumustahan**. This activity will serve as an opportunity for participants to share their experiences, successes and challenges and assess their learning to have a more effective implementation of the ASRH program in the coming school year.

With this, we are kindly requesting our trained peer educators and guidance counselor for a two (2) day **Peer Educators' Kamustahan** on **March 9-10, 2020 at KKKK Session Hall, Manresa Farm, Masterson Avenue**. The program will start at 8:30 in the morning on March 9 and will end by 3 in the afternoon of March 10. KKKK will shoulder the participants' cost of transportation, meals and accommodation. All participants will be billeted at the South East Asian Rural Social Leadership Institute (SEARSOLIN). Also, in adherence to the Child Safeguarding Policy, we would ensure to secure parents consent of all children participating the activity.
