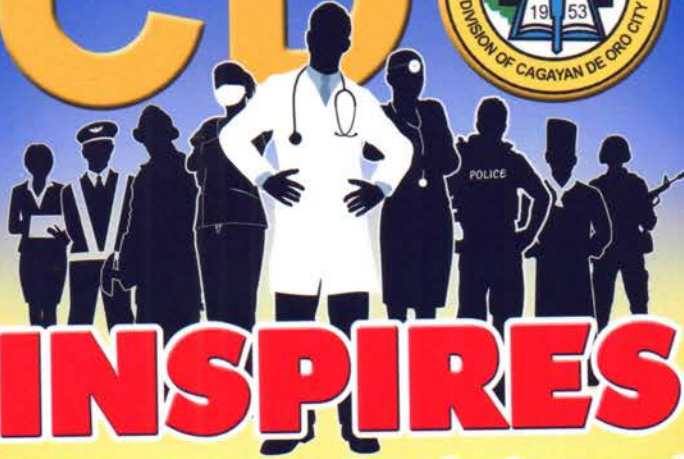

Project Rationale

It was December 31, 2019 when the World Health Organization (WHO) received official reports about a pneumonia cluster of cases from the unknown cause which was detected in the Wuhan City, Hubei Province of China. Later on, it was named as Coronavirus Disease 2019 or also known as COVID-19. Chinese authorities identified COVID-19 as a disease causative virus on January 7, 2020.

As the World Health Organisation (2020) emphasizes, COVID-19 is an infectious disease caused by the most recent coronavirus. The virus can cause illness in both humans and animals to more serious diseases such as Middle East Respiratory Syndrome (MERS) and Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS), such as common cold. The most common symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, tiredness and dry cough. Some patients, on the other hand, can experience aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose, sore throat and/or diarrhea. Many people get sick but have no symptoms, and don't feel unwell. Approximately 80% of infected people recover from the disease without special care.

A recent research published in The New England Journal of Medicine found that the virus that causes COVID-19 persists on surfaces and in aerosols for several hours to days. The study indicates that people can acquire coronavirus through the air and after infected items are touched. Scientists have found the virus to be soluble in aerosols for up to three hours, in copper for up to four hours, in cardboard for up to 24 hours, and in plastic and stainless steel for up to two to three days.

There are 1,279,722 confirmed cases worldwide as of April 7, 2020, while 9,132 confirmed cases in South East Asia and the Philippines have 3870 confirmed cases, 96 were able to recover and 182 died (WHO, 2020). Consequently, the Philippine government has implemented policies and steps on urban quarantine to restrict population movement. In order to combat the COVID-19 pandemic in the Philippines, Luzon Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) prompted the mobilization of the Philippine government agencies and local government units as well as the passage of the Republic Act 11489 or the 'Bayanihan to Recover as One Act.' The lockdown has an economic, financial, political, social and cultural effect, affecting about 57 million people who are quarantined.

Pursuant to an Executive Order (EO) No. 049-2020, the mayor put Cagayan de Oro City under community quarantine. The city mayor ordered the closure of malls, entertainment centers, bars, and other non-essential shops on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 to prevent people from converging together. Additionally, the city mayor signed an Executive Order (EO) No. 052 Series 2020 for "An Order Implementing the Department of Transportation's (DOTr) Social Distancing Guidelines in Cagayan de Oro City and For Other Purposes."

In the midst of COVID-19 pandemic, our Kagay-anon nurses, doctors and other health professionals, police and military law enforcers, and researchers acted as our frontlines. As health heroes, frontliners find the courage to defeat COVID-19. They gave their skills, their dedication and, most importantly, they risked their lives to save other lives.

Project Descriptions

Thus, Department of Education Division of Cagayan de Oro City recognizes the heartfelt efforts and energy of our frontliners, therefore, launches **CDO INSPIRES**, which stands for Cagayan de Oro Instrumental and Appraisal support for Ingenious fRontlinErS. This project highlights the main support components-the instrumental and the appraisal. The instrumental support refers to any tangible assistance and service provided to the selfless frontliners that includes health supplies such as bottled water, food packs, face masks, face shields, alcohol, medicines, gloves, sanitizers, coffee, and other resources that they need to continue to do very important work for Kagay-anon. On the other hand, appraisal (or emotional) support includes expressing our love, empathy and care to our frontliners by sending them inspirational love notes and quotes, texts, emails, poems, and prayers via online channels such as FB page (DepEd Tayo) and even offline mode.

In addition, all teaching and non-teaching personnel including the learners are encouraged to create an inspirational messages, poems, quotations, video clips, etc. and upload it to the FB page platform for easy and quick access to the Ingenious frontliners. Frontliners are described as Ingenious considering that they became resourceful and innovative in their respective stations to help combat the pandemic.

Project Objectives

CDO inspires to do following for the frontliners: (1) provide tangible aid or assistance via food packs, giftpacks and other grocery items, and health supplies; and (2) utilize DepEd Tayo Cagayan de Oro FB page for the uploading of inspirational messages, poems, quotations, video clips and original song composition.

Project Mechanics

Instrumental Support (Food packs/Giftpacks/Grocery Items offering for the Frontliners)

- A. All division personnel and ManCom family members are encouraged to contribute an amount of at least Php 200.00 for the purchase of food packs, giftpacks and other grocery items, face masks, and face shields for the frontliners in Cagayan de Oro City.

- B. The Php200.00 will be collected through the office of the Social Mobilization and Networking Linkages in the Schools Governance and Operations Division on or before April 15, 2020. Attention Dr. Jean T. Loquillano and Jimboy Eugenio
- C. One hundred fifty thousand pesos (Php 150, 000.00) will be the target amount to be generated. The said amount will be used for the procurement of health supplies, food packs and grocery items as well as gift packs.
- D. Cash or noncash donations (health supplies) from teaching and nonteaching as well as generous stakeholders will also be accepted and collected via the SGOD office. All donations shall be properly accounted with the support from the staff of M and E office.
- E. Ms. Laverne Mercado shall lead the procurement of food packs / gift packs and other grocery items on April 15, 2020. Constant coordination is to be developed between and among supply office workers and social mobilization and networking linkages.
- F. Ryan Blanco, Project Development Officer for Disaster Readiness and Risk Reduction Management, in close coordination with SGOD Chief Rosalio R. Vitorillo and the City DRRMO, will lead the distribution of food packs, gift packs, grocery items and other health supplies on April 16, 2020 onward. SDO personnel shall take charge with the NMMC frontline employees and School Heads shall distribute the support package to all front liners assigned in various check points within the city.
- G. All activities related to this project shall be properly documented by the personnel from the Office of Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E). Attention Eleanor Rollan

Appraisal Support 1.1 (Love Quotes and Videos Offering for the Frontliners)

- A. The staff from the Learning Resource Management Center shall draft a memorandum inviting teaching and non-teaching personnel including learners to write an inspirational message, poems, quotes and or create an inspirational video clip for the frontliners.
- B. The Youth Formation Officers (Jairus Gochuco and Leah Manzano) as well as the staff from the Human Resource and Development section (Derrold Aves and Mary Sieras) shall create a platform via online/offline for the delivery of inspirational messages, poems, quotations, video clips for the frontliners.

C. All commendable inspirational messages, poems and quotes shall be compiled by the Librarian, Lanie Signo for further validation so that it will be published in the LRMS portal and it shall be used as enrichment learning resources across learning areas.

Appraisal Support 1.2 (Love-Song Offering for the Frontliners)

- A. Teacher and learner-singers are encouraged to develop and share their own song composition which is offered to our health heroes, the frontliners of COVID-19
- B. All commendable original song compositions will be uploaded in the DepEd Tayo FB page and or any platforms designed by the Youth Formation Officers and HRD staff

Appraisal Support 1.3 (Artworks Offering for the Frontliners)

- A. Teaching and non-teaching personnel including learners who have passion and talents for drawing, graphic designs, animation, and painting are invited to share their talents for uplifting our frontliners
- B. Reviewing the artworks shall be done by the Division Pool of Illustrators and Evaluators
- C. The admin of DepEd Tayo Cagayan de Oro City FB page shall upload the commendable artworks for quick viewing for the stakeholders and frontliners. Attention Ms Pureza Villar Camonias

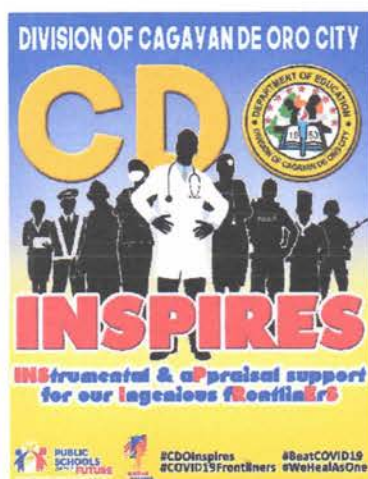


Fig 1 Project INSPIRE ID
