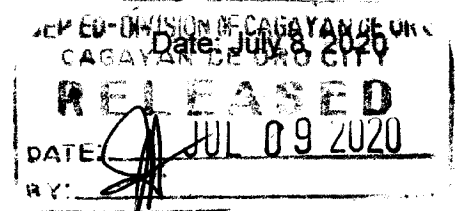

7. health protocols and practices per school
