

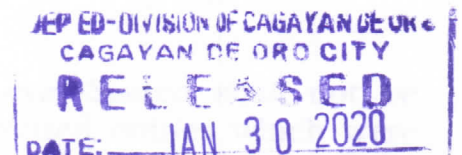

4. The winning entries in every district (elementary and secondary) shall accomplish the *entry templates 1 and 2 supporting the criterion "*Functional Reading Program*" in category "Best School Reading Program Implementer."

5. Districts who were not able to conduct the District Level Search shall not be included in the Division Evaluation. Hence, only the submitted entries which were properly endorsed by the Public Schools District Supervisor are considered official entries.

6. During the evaluation, the winning entry of each district shall prepare the evaluation/scoring sheet in 4 copies per category inserted in a cardboard folder. E-copy can be accessed thru the link: <http://bit.ly/2FBFMrz>

7. It shall be emphasized that the evaluation is a document-based for categories (a) best school reading program implementer and (b) outstanding reading teacher, while for the (c) best reading clinic it shall be both document and actual/on-site validation. Any documents not found in the packaged entry submitted shall no longer be entertained for later submission. Hence, evaluators will no longer ask whether a particular document/MOV is available or not.

8. Further, for added technical assistance to the school's reading program, evaluators shall document through writing the unavailability of that particular document(s) at the time of evaluation for future preparation and continuous improvement.

9. To promote a culture of reading and stronger support of the whole school community's commitment to the integrity of the program, this office shall award the 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd place winners in the Division Level Search. However, only the first place winner shall be the official entry to the Regional Level Search in each category.

10. The decision of the committee is final and shall be respected. The committee shall not entertain questions regarding the selection of finalists and winners.
