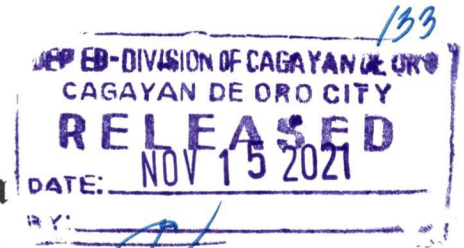



1. In line with DepEd Order 13 s. 2015 on establishing a policy development process for the systematic, participatory, and evidence-based formulation, adoption, and review of basic education policies of the Department, the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD) will conduct a **Virtual Policy Review** via Google Meet, on November 19, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
2. The participants, in consultation with other program holders from the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) and School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) shall identify a DepEd Order as subject of the policy review.
3. The identified DepEd Orders for the activity must be (a) issued from 2010 onwards, (b) active or are presently being implemented, and (c) relevant to office operations.
4. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall **prepare a five-minute PowerPoint presentation** using the attached template, which shall be emailed in advance at pprd.region10@deped.gov.ph and cc'd at allan.mansalateza@deped.gov.ph not later than 9:00 p.m. of November 18.
5. All the participants will have logged in, at least, 10 minutes before the start of the activity for checking of attendance.
6. Attached is the list of participants.

GUIDE IN EVALUATING A POLICY

1. Identify the root cause of the problem in the implementation of the programs/projects.
2. Identify all “presumably” relevant policies relevant to the ROOT CAUSE.
3. Find out if the policies are relevant, e.g., they really aim to solve the problem you identified.
 - a) If relevant, go to Step 4.
 - b) If not relevant, discard and look for other policies (be exhaustive).
 - c) If you can't find relevant policy, there is a **POLICY PROBLEM** – the lack of public policy that addresses your root problem/cause
4. Gather data on the performance of the implementation of those policies.
5. Using your data, evaluate the performance of the implementation of the policies. Use the following evaluation criteria, i.e., effectiveness, efficiency, adequacy, equity, responsiveness, etc.

If the policy outcomes or performance does not satisfy your criteria, then there is perhaps a **POLICY PROBLEM** - an operational policy problem.

- ✓ Conflicting policies
- ✓ Unresponsive policies/mismatched policies
- ✓ Ineffective
- ✓ Inefficient
- ✓ Inequitable
- ✓ Etc.

- ✓ What are the advantages and disadvantages of these alternatives?

Recommendations:
