RE : 2021 LIONS INTERNATIONAL PEACE POSTER CONTEST

Girl Scouts of the Philippines is invited by the Lions Club International to join the **2021 Lions International Peace Poster Contest** with the theme ***"We Are All Connected"***. It is a great opportunity for our girls to think about peace, creatively express what it means to them and to share their own unique visions with the world.

The contests are open to Junior and Senior Girl Scouts who are between the ages of 11, 12 and 13. They can send entry for only one (1) category. Below are the guidelines and contest rules.

I. Guidelines for Peace Poster Contest

- a. The contest is open to Junior and Senior Girl Scouts who will be 11, 12 or 13 years of age on November 15, 2021. Eligible birth dates are November 16, 2005 to November 15, 2008.
- b. Artwork must be no smaller than 13 inches by 20 inches (33 cm by 50 cm) and no larger than 20 inches by 24 inches (50 cm by 60 cm). Do not mat or frame artwork.
- c. Only one (1) entry per Girl Scout and each entry must be the work of only one (1) Girl Scout contestant.
- d. All artwork must be the individual's original creation. Duplications are not accepted.
- e. All kinds medium is accepted. Note: Chalk, charcoal and pastel entries should be sealed with a fixative spray to prevent smearing. Do not laminate entries.
- f. Three-dimensional entries will not be accepted. Nothing may be glued, stapled or attached to the artwork in any way.
- g. The use of **lettering or numbering on the front of the poster, in any language, and logo is not allowed**. Artist's signatures or initials should be written on the back of the poster.
- h. Artwork should be done on a flexible material, so it can be rolled for shipping in a mailing tube. Do not fold poster.
- i. All entries must be submitted and received by the GSP National Headquarters Program Division **on or before October 30, 2021**. There will be no extension for submission of entries. Late entries will not be part of the judging process.

II. Awards (Peace Poster Contest)

All entries from GSP will receive Certificates of Participation and a badge under the Challenge of the Arts. Lions Club shall sponsor cash prizes for the GSP Top 3 entries.

Representatives from GSP and Lions Club shall judge all entries and shall choose top three for Poster contests. The top three entries of GSP shall be the official entries to Lion's Club District Judging.
