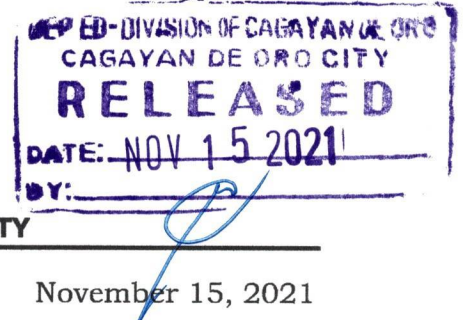

4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

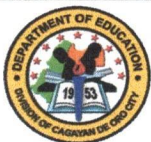

ANNEX A:

MECHANICS FOR SONG COVER CONTEST

1. In cognizant to **OUA Memo No. 00-1121-0025**, the theme for the Division Level celebration will be the core values **“Maka-Diyos”**. Hence, all submitted Song Cover entries must also have relevance to the theme **“Maka-Diyos”**.
2. The contest is open to ALL Public Secondary School Students of this Division, and each School is entitled **one (1) entry**. If there are more than one entry per School, the School SSG Officers shall *facilitate the selection and endorsement* of only one (1) entry.
3. All entries must be recorded in MP4 format and must be a high-quality video (*Size 1920x1080, 25 FPS, High Definition. No Portrait*). Entries must not also exceed five (5) mins.
4. The song cover can be in *English, Tagalog, or Bisaya/Cebuano*. It can also be performed *Solo, Duet, or Group/Band*.
5. All performers must be a bonafide student of the participating school.
6. All entries must be submitted on or before November 18, 2021, 12:00 Noon on the designated google drive folder: **<https://tinyurl.com/NSDCDOsongcover>**
7. All submitted entries that are eligible will be posted on DepEd -Tayo – Youth Formation – Division of Cagayan de Oro City FB Page on **November 19, 2021 starting from 8:00 AM**.
8. The top 3 winners will be selected **based on the number of FB reactions** the uploaded videos will receive.
9. The top 3 winners will be announced after the live countdown during the Division Virtual NSD 2021 Celebration.
10. Strict compliance of the mechanics must be observed. Any violation of the mechanics may be a ground for disqualification and forfeiture of entry.



ANNEX B:

MECHANICS FOR DIGITAL ART CONTEST

1. In cognizant to **OUA Memo No. 00-1121-0025**, the theme for the Division Level celebration will be in-lined to core values "*Maka-Diyos*". Hence, all submitted Digital Art entries must have relevance with the specific theme:

Theme: "*Gunam-gunamin sa sarili tuwina, na ang matapat na pagsampalataya sa Kanya ay ang pag-ibig sa lupang tinubuan, sapagkat ito ang tunay na pag-ibig sa kapwa.*"

-- Ikalawang Dekalogo ng Katipunan

2. The contest is open to ALL Public School Grade 3 -12 Student of this Division, and each School is entitled **one (1) entry**. If there are more than one entry per School, the School SSG/SPG Officers shall *facilitate the selection and endorsement* of only one (1) entry.
3. There shall be **2 categories** for this contest; (1) **Elementary**, and (2) **High School**.
4. Entries should be in high resolution JPEG format, preferably with **minimum dimensions of 1080 x 1920 pixels, and 300 dpi**. The Digital Art entries must be created with digital technology and presented in various formats of stand-alone digital art image such as, but not limited to:
 - Graphic Poster
 - Data-Moshing
 - 3D Computer Graphics
 - Photo-Painting
 - Integrated Art/Mixed Media/Hybrid Painting
 - Computer-Generated Painting
 - Web Comic
 - Dynamic Painting
 - Pixel Art
 - Manual Vector Drawing
 - Fractal/Algorithmic Art
 - 2D Computer Graphics
 - Digital Photography
 - Raster Painting
5. All participants must be a bonafide student of the participating school.
6. All entries must be submitted on or before **November 18, 2021, 12:00 Noon** at the designated google drive folder: **<https://tinyurl.com/NSDCDOdigitalart>**
7. Each Category will have one (1) Winner. Winners will be selected by a panel of judges, whose decision will be final. Entries will be judged according to the following merits:
 - o Originality of the work concept
 - o Relevance to the Theme and Interpretation
 - o Unity of Composition of Elements
 - o Technical Proficiency and Creative Use of Digital Media
8. The winners for this contest **will be announced on a later date**.
9. All submissions must become the sole property of DepEd – CDO YFD and may be used for any purpose relevant to its mandate and not for commercial purposes. Artists may not use their winning images without the expressed written permission of the DepEd - CDO YFD.
