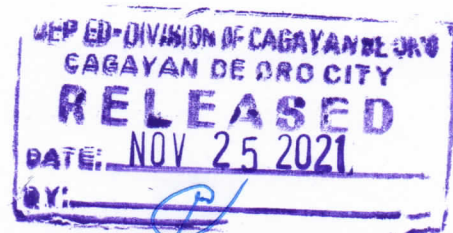

**NATIONAL VACCINATION DRIVE AGAINST COVID-19
ON NOVEMBER 29-30 AND DECEMBER 1, 2021**

To: This Division Health Personnel

1. In light of the government's aim in fast tracking the vaccination roll-out there will be a national vaccination drive against COVID-19 on November 29-30 and December 1, 2021. Additional medical personnel will be needed; thus, all DepEd Division Health Personnel are mandated to serve as vaccinators during the 3-day immunization drive as members of the vaccination team.
2. Pursuant to DepEd Regional Memorandum No. 722, s. 2021, all National Government agencies are enjoined to serve as volunteers, especially the medical, nursing and allied health professionals; teachers, professors, and school personnel; data professionals, encoders and students.
3. Further, you are directed to coordinate with the LGU-Vaccination Unit regarding your functions for the said activity.

**BAYANIHAN, BAKUNAHAN NATIONAL COVID-19 VACCINATION DAYS
ON NOVEMBER 29, 30, AND DECEMBER 1, 2021**

1. With reference to the National Government's Declaration of the National Vaccination Day (NVD) on November 29, 30, and December 1, all National Government agencies are enjoined to serve as volunteers, especially the medical, nursing, and allied health professionals; teachers, professors, and school personnel; data professionals, encoders, and students.
2. Attached is the Advisory No. 102 from the NVOC dated November 18, 2021 for reference. DepEd's participation on NVD is stipulated in the attached DepEd Task Force Covid-19 Memorandum No. 556 s 2021 for guidance.

BAYANIHAN, BAKUNAHAN NATIONAL COVID-19 VACCINATION DAYS

To: Undersecretaries

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) fully supports the implementation of the enclosed Presidential Proclamation No. 1253 **Declaring 29 November to 01 December 2021 as *Bayanihan, Bakunahan National COVID-19 Vaccination Days***.
2. All teaching and nonteaching personnel, parents, and learners from 12 years of age are encouraged to get vaccinated and support the government's vaccination program against COVID-19. This is also crucial in the implementation of the face-to-face learning modality and its eventual expansion, as well as in the normalization of our agency operations.
3. In accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 1253, all teaching and nonteaching personnel, including regular plantilla, casual, contractual, and contract of service (COS) personnel, who will be vaccinated during the aforesaid period, shall not be considered absent from their work, provided that they present proof of vaccination to the heads of functional offices.
4. All learners who will be vaccinated during the aforesaid period shall be considered excused from attending classes, provided that they present proof of vaccination to their teachers.
5. Relevant units at the DepEd central, regional, and schools division offices shall coordinate with counterparts from the Department of Health, Department of the Interior and Local Government, local government units, and the National Task Force (NTF) Against COVID-19 to provide the necessary support and assistance for the effective implementation of the Presidential Proclamation.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
