

SCHEDULE OF TRAINING ENHANCEMENT FOR DIVISIONAL DEPED TV TEAMS

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- 1. As regards Regional Memorandum No. 676, s. 2021 re Training Enhancement for Divisional DepEd TV Teams, the activity will be conducted on January 17-21, 2022 due to earlier schedules already set.
- 2. At the end of the activity, the participants are expected to achieve the following:
 - a. Master the basics of operating video field equipment including camera, audio, and lighting;
 - b. Use digital editing and multiple video elements together (images, sound, interviews, music, etc.) to achieve learning objectives in a lesson:
 - c. Feel confident in the basics of creating and overseeing a field production such as pre-production, production, direction, and post-production; and
 - d. Empower the teachers in the delivery of instruction in front of the camera.
- 3. The expected participants from all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) will be a core team of five members with the following qualifications:
 - a. Four members must be DepEd teaching or nonteaching personnel with background and skills in any of the following: media arts, videography, photography, video editing, directing and writing; and
 - b. One DepEd teacher-broadcaster who has pleasing personality and excellent oral and written communication skills





- 4. Each team shall take the following equipment to the workshop:
 - a. camera (DSLR),
 - b. tripod,
 - c. ring lights,
 - d. studio video lights (if available),
 - e. prompter (if available),
 - f. lapel or clip-on microphone,
 - g. editing laptop (at least core i5),
 - h. memory cards,
 - i. extension wires, and
 - j. chroma cloth.
