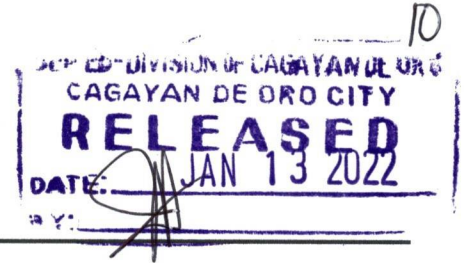

Greetings from Save the Children!

We do whatever it takes for children – every day and in times of crisis – transforming their lives and the future we share.

Save the Children is an organization fighting for children's right to a future. We believe that every child deserves a future. In the Philippines and around the world, we work every day to give children a healthy start in life, the opportunity to learn and protection from harm. When crisis strikes, and children are most vulnerable, we are always among the first to respond and the last to leave. We ensure children's unique needs are met and their voices are heard. We deliver lasting results for millions of children, including those hardest to reach.

Together with UNICEF, The Asia Foundation, and with support from the Australian government, we are currently implementing the **SaferKidsPH program "Enhancing Child Protection System to Keep Filipino Children Safe Online Program"**. This is a 5-year program, and for the first 2 years, we are partnering with four barangays, four schools, and local service providers and law enforcement in Iligan and Cagayan de Oro cities.

To equip students on online safety, our partner schools- Sacred Heart Village Elementary School and PN Roa Elementary and High Schools developed online safety modules that we plan to pilot on the second quarter of the School Year 2021-2022. These are guided by the Cybersafe materials in which the teachers have already been trained.

The modules cover different topics related to internet and communications technology use, and the general aim of these materials is to continue educating the students on how to keep themselves safe while navigating the cyberspace, be it for educational or entertainment purposes.

We would like to ensure that the materials are gender sensitive and disability inclusive, and at par with the standards of the Department of Education prior to the pilot testing with the partner schools. In this light, we would like to seek your support to make sure that the materials are age-appropriate and relevant by reviewing the draft modules.
