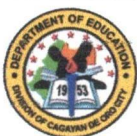

Thematic plenary and breakout sessions will follow with selected presenters from the SERG-supported regions, divisions, and schools. SERG-developed **Mobile Apps** for teachers will also be launched.


