A critical component of all programs is impact assessment. In partnership with Ateneo de Manila University, SBFI have developed short English Reading student assessments that teachers training participants can voluntarily administer to their students. In return, SBFI will be giving monetary incentives to teachers who will have the:

- Most number of learners administered with the exam; and
- Highest average score of all learners administered with the exam provided average score is at least 80%.

Below is the schedule of the impact assessments. Teachers may have their students answer via online or printed exam with the link and templates to be provided by the Foundation immediately after the corresponding virtual elementary English teachers training per grade level.
