2021 DEPED REGION X ONLINE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

Mechanics

What and when is this activity?

The Department of Education (DepEd) Region X will hold the **2021 DepEd Region X Online Photography Contest**. The Regional Office X will be accepting entries until December 24.

All entries shall be anchored on the theme: "DepEd NorMin: Standing Tall in the Face of the Pandemic." The photos must portray DepEd NorMin's resilience, commitment, and vision as evidenced by the effective planning, implementation, evaluation, and recalibration of the divisions' and schools' projects, initiatives, and innovations not only amidst the current pandemic but beyond.

Who may join?

The contest is open to all DepEd teaching, nonteaching, and teaching-related employees.

What are the guidelines for submission?

- 1. Each participating Schools Division Office (SDO) is allowed to submit three entries per category.
- 2. Upon submission of their entries, the participants shall guarantee the originality of their works that they are in no way an infringement upon the rights of others. As owners of these works, the participants shall likewise waive their rights in favor of the Department of Education (DepEd) for its Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) advocacy materials and activities. However, the owner-participants and their works will always be acknowledged properly or given due recognition.
- 3. Entries shall be endorsed officially by the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent (OSDS).
- 4. Entries shall be submitted only via https://bit.ly/2021norminphotocontest; otherwise, they will not be accepted as official entries.
- 5. This activity shall be led by the divisional campus journalism coordinators, information technology officers, or any one commissioned by the Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs).

- Entries shall include the following details: 6.
 - a. Name, sex, age, e-mail address, contact number, and school/office;
 - b. Photograph caption (1-2 sentences describing the photograph and its relevance to the theme);
 - c. Complete name of the place where the photograph was taken (barangay, town/municipality, city, province); and
 - d. Date when the photograph was taken.
- File name of photographs should be in the following format: Program, 7. Surname, First Name, Middle Initial.

What are the photo requirements?

- Photographs must be original and not contain copyrighted materials. Only colored photographs will be accepted. Black and white or sepia photographs will be automatically disqualified.
- Photographs must be in digital JPEG or JPG format (horizontal image or vertical image) with at least 300 pixels per inch.
- Photographs must not be digitally altered (colorized, toned, assembled, 3. blended, stitched panorama, etc.) and/or enhanced in any way.
- Works that have won prizes in other contests or that have been submitted to other contests underway, including similar works, are ineligible. Moreover, works submitted to other competitions after submission to this contest will also be regarded as ineligible.

What are the criteria for judging?

Photos will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- Content and Adherence to the Theme (30%) 1.
- Visual Impact, including Color and Lighting (25%) 2.
- Creativity and Originality (25%) 3.
- Quality (20%) 4.

Total: 100%

What are the prizes?

- Regional winners of each category will receive the following: 1.
 - a. 1st Prize Winner Plaque of Recognition
 - b. 2nd and 3rd Prize Winners Certificate of Recognition
- Non-winners will receive certificates of participation. 2.
