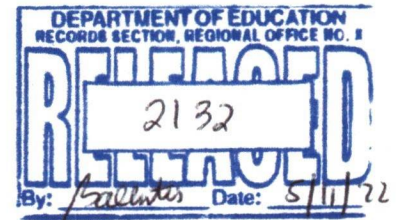

As our partner in gender mainstreaming at the regional and local levels, **we are pleased to invite the member agencies of Regional GAD Committees (RGADCs) to the third GAD Webinar for 2022 of PCW**, titled, **“Gender Analysis: Tools and Praxis”**, **scheduled on 19 May 2022, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**. This learning session aims to influence public servants to support gender equality and women's empowerment by discussing Gender Analysis (GA) as a crucial element in gender mainstreaming. The session intends to enhance appreciation of participants on GA as the process of asking essential questions to understand the differences of women and men in terms of gender needs and interests, capabilities, roles and responsibilities, access to and control of resources, benefits, and opportunities as well as constraints to participation and decision-making. This session will also discuss gender analysis tools and frameworks to surface gender issues among women and men, girls and boys in households and communities.
