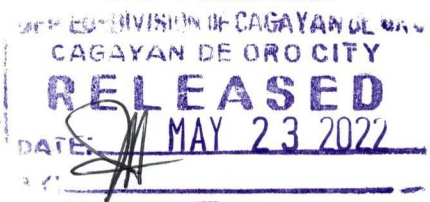

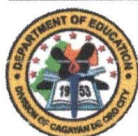

1. Relative to the **Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) Memorandum No. 00-0322-0001** titled **Guidelines on the Utilization of FY 2022 Comprehensive Release Fund (CRF) under Disaster Preparedness and Response Program (DPRP) Fund**, this Office enjoins concerned permanent divisional DRRM coordinators in the Region (1 pax per SDO) to attend the **2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter DRRM Coordination Meeting vis-à-vis DRRM Thematic Areas Workshop Activity** on **May 25-27** at a venue (to be announced) in Cagayan de Oro City.

2. The coordination meeting aims to discuss the following agenda:

- a. Updating of divisional DRRM coordinators directory;
- b. Fund utilization status for FY 2021 (continuing funds) and FY 2022 including clean-up and repair downloaded funds;
- c. Inventory of PFA/MHPSS trained personnel per SDO;
- d. TS Odette QRF approved allocations and list of schools for NDRRM funding;
- e. Proposed regional and divisional DRRM/CCA/EiE programs, projects, and activities for FY 2022;
- f. Child protection in emergencies;
- g. Quarterly reporting of DRRM/CCA/EiE activities including NSED;
- h. RADaR application concerns;
- i. DRRM social media management for the region and divisions;
- j. Search for Outstanding Implementing Schools on Disaster Preparedness, Prevention & Mitigation, Response, and Rehabilitation and Recovery (Resiliency Excellence Awards); and
- k. Other matters



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3. In connection, following the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) as it fulfills the requirement of RA 10121 of 2010, which provides the legal basis for policies, plans and programs to deal with disasters, the DRRM thematic areas workshop activity primarily intends to:

- a. reinforce hazard prevention and mitigate their potential impacts by reducing vulnerabilities and exposure and by enhancing capacities of schools;
- b. strengthen capacities of schools to anticipate, cope and recover from the negative impacts of emergency occurrences and disasters;
- c. promote life preservation and meet the basic subsistence needs of affected learners and personnel based on acceptable standards during or immediately after a disaster; and
- d. boost restoration and improvement of facilities and organizational capacities of the affected schools and help reduce disaster risks in accordance with the "building back better" principle.

4. The participants are expected to arrive on May 25. Registration starts at 1:00 p.m., and PM snacks will be served as first meal. Check-in is at 2:00 p.m., but the opening program starts at 1:30 p.m. Check-out is on May 27 in the afternoon with lunch as last meal of the activity.


5. The participants per division shall take with them their laptops, extension wires, and comfortable sporty attires for the breakout workshops and activities.

6. Board and lodging shall be charged against the DPRP funds of the Regional Office (RO). Travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
